2. Jesus is the Son of Man (v. 69)

He was given authority, glory and sovereign power; all nations and peoples of every language worshiped him. 3. Jesus Can Identify With The Canceled And Condemned

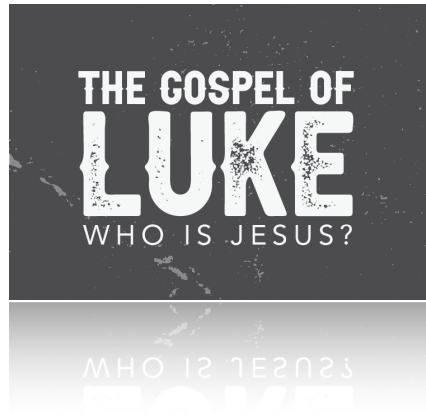
