

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ.

As Advent approaches, I am reminded of the themes for each Sunday.

The first Sunday is marked by **Hope**. Primarily, this encourages us to not just think about Jesus' first coming, but also of his Second Coming. For Christians going through difficult times, this can be the proverbial light at the end of the tunnel. Whether those difficulties are oppression and persecution, sickness and health, poverty or something else, it is the thought of Jesus' return that gives us hope.

The second Sunday's theme is **Peace**. This shows up in the nativity story at the end of Zechariah's song in Luke 1 and more importantly it is proclaimed by the angels to the Shepherds in Luke 2:14, "Glory to God in the highest heaven, and on earth peace among those whom he favors." In Romans 5:1, Paul tells his readers that "through faith, we have peace with God."

During the third Sunday, we celebrate **Joy**. We are told in Luke 1, that Jesus's cousin John "leaped for joy" in Elizabeth's womb, when she heard Mary's greeting. Also on the night of Jesus' birth, the angel said that he was bringing "good news of great joy for all the people." Of course, numerous Christmas hymns echo the theme of joy.

For the final Sunday, God's **Love** is proclaimed. We are told in John 3:16 that it was because of His love that God sent His Son for us. In Romans 5, we are told that "God proves his love for us in that while we still were sinners Christ died for us." This message of God's love permeates the Gospels and the rest of the New Testament.

I hope that this Advent and Christmas season that you will take some time to reflect on these themes and what they mean to you.

May you have a blessed Advent and Christmas season.
