### Day 1 Sunday with Max Lucado Be Anxious for Nothing

Lucado guided us to C.A.L.M. through Philippians 4:4-9: Celebrate our God with praise and thanksgiving, Ask God through prayer, Leave our concerns with Him in trust, and Meditate on true and good things. The result is peace.

#### Day 2 Monday Jesus is Lord

The definition of Lord is one possessed of absolute control, master. We were asked to pray with more listening than asking. As Jesus died by crucifixion for us, we prayed to die to ourselves (how we see, hear, think, understand, act), our flesh (appetites, pride, greed, lusts), and the world (idols, sports, TV/News, culture), while recognizing Jesus as our Lord.

#### Jesus is our Peace
