DRIVE THRU HISTORY: THE GOSPELS

Drive Thru History: The Gospels tells the story of Jesus from the locations recorded in the Gospels of Matthew, Mark, Luke and John. Dave Stotts travels to over 50 ancient sites in Israel to deliver the Gospels in a fresh way, show the evidence for the truth of scripture, and encourage participants to get excited about reading the Bible again.

Dave Stotts will take you on a unique driving tour of Israel to experience the actual places where Jesus traveled and taught. 18 episodes dive into the history, archaeology, geography and art surrounding the birth, ministry, death and resurrection of Jesus.

Scott and Sandra Coleman will facilitate the presentations, leading a question-and-answer period after each episode in order to promote discussion and amplify understanding.
