SINCE THEIR ARRIVAL, MITCH AND AMANDA HAVE SEEN *Miracles* UNFOLD





Since the pandemic began in 2020, our outreach has not only expanded but has become a beacon of hope for many. Every time we gather, we distribute approximately **45-50,000 pounds of food** to at least **1,300 families** which provides about **40,000 meals!**

As of October 2024, our cumulative total for the year in partnering with **more than 50 churches**, we distributed over **1.4 million pounds of food** that reach **36,846 families**—equating to an incredible **1.2 million meals**. Each meal is a step toward restoring dignity and hope for our neighbors.

IMB's history continues, and its strategies to reach the world change as the world changes. What has not changed is the strong commitment of Southern Baptists to join the author of history in his redemptive movement to advance his gospel among all peoples.

As a church, we currently support three families from First Baptist in North Africa and the Middle East.

Nissi Project of Pensacola – Bridging the gap between a survivor's rescue and restoration. The mission of The Nissi Project of Pensacola is a short-term, immediate care home program for Human Trafficked (HT) verified or Commercial Sexual Exploitation of a Child (CSEC) children from the time they are rescued to the time they are ready to arrive at an aftercare facility.

Health and Hope Clinic – The Clinic was founded in 2003 by the Pensacola Bay Baptist Association, providing hope and healthcare to meet the needs of the uninsured and medically underserved in Escambia County, Florida. If you are a physician, nurse, or pharmacist and are looking for an opportunity to serve, the Health and Hope Clinic could be your answer.

Fellowship of Christian Athletes - The vision of FCA is to see the world transformed by Jesus Christ through the influence of coaches and athletes. Their mission is to lead every coach and athlete into a growing relationship with Jesus Christ and His Church. With multiple opportunities to get involved like small groups, camps, Coaches Ministry, and International Trips, FCA is a great ministry for those who have a passion for coaches and athletes.



Each year, through Operation Christmas Child (OCC), a project of Samaritan's Purse, our church joins thousands of other churches to send over 10 million gift filled shoeboxes to share the love of Christ with children in desperate need around the globe. Each shoebox we pack isn't just a collection of toys and school supplies; it's a powerful message of the hope, faith, and love found in Christianity that reaches children affected by war, poverty, natural disasters, and famine.

A MISSION WITH A *Purpose*

From the beginning, our First Baptist Church family has partnered with OCC to share Good News and Great Joy to children. This is a year around ministry. In just the last two years, our volunteer family has packed over 12,000 shoeboxes. But OCC is not just about a child opening a gift filled shoebox; OCC is about what the shoebox opens for the child—a connection to the child's local church where the child hears the Good News of Jesus Christ, sparking the potential for a lifelong relationship with Him. This is not merely charity; it's a transformative mission that ignites hope in the hearts of children and families around the world.

Why It Matters: THE GREATEST JOURNEY

In every box we pack, there lies the potential to change a life. Imagine a child living in a third world country, or a child who lives in a community hit hard by a natural disaster receiving a gift filled shoebox from their local pastor who has been vetted, trained and equipped by Samaritan's Purse to share the Good News of Jesus Christ with children. Not only does the pastor share the Good News of Jesus Christ when the shoebox is distributed, the pastor also invites children to return to the church to attend a 12-week discipleship program called the "Greatest Journey."

During these 12 weeks, children learn about God's sovereignty, Jesus' love and sacrifice, how to live a Christian life, and how to share their faith with their family and friends.

One in every five children who receive a shoebox return to their local church, complete all 12 lessons of the Greatest Journey and make a first-time decision to accept Jesus as their personal savior.

Receiving a shoebox can be transformative—not just for the child but for entire communities as they come to know Christ through local churches empowered by these gifts. Together, we can make a profound difference in the lives of children around the world, one child and one shoebox at a time.

With these essentials, girls can focus on their education instead of being forced into desperate situations, like exchanging sex for basic needs or being married off at a young age.


