### Today's Scripture Colossians 3:1-11 ESV

If then you have been raised with Christ, seek the things that are above, where Christ is, seated at the right hand of God.<sup>2</sup> Set your minds on things that are above, not on things that are on earth. <sup>3</sup> For you have died, and your life is hidden with Christ in God. ⁴ When Christ who is your [a] life appears, then you also will appear with him in glory. <sup>5</sup> Put to death therefore what is earthly in you: [b] sexual immorality, impurity, passion, evil desire, and covetousness, which is idolatry. 6 On account of these the wrath of God is coming.
