THE GREAT THANKSGIVING

The Lord be with you.
And also with you.
Lift up your hearts.
We lift them up to the Lord.
Let us give thanks to the Lord our God.
It is right to give our thanks and praise.

Father Almighty, Creator of heaven and earth.
You created us and gave us life. Yet, in our sin we
have forsaken You. You have demonstrated Your
redemption to us every day, and have remained
our Sovereign God. So now, we praise Your Name
and join the unending hymn:

Holy, holy, holy Lord, God of power and might,
heaven and earth are full of your glory.
Hosanna in the highest.
Blessed is he who comes in the name of the
Lord. Hosanna in the highest.

We praise the Name and work of our Lord and
Savior Jesus Christ. Through Him, Your salvation
has been made flesh. And through His life, death,
and resurrection, You have called those who
believe into the community of new life.

On the night in which He gave Himself up for us,
He broke the bread, gave it to His disciples, and
said: "Take, eat; this is my body which is given for
you . Do this in remembrance of me." When the
supper was over He gave the cup to His disciples,
and said: "Drink from this, all of you; this is my
blood of the new covenant, poured out for you
and for many for the forgiveness of sins. Do this,
as often as you drink it, in remembrance of me."

thanksgiving as a holy and living sacrifice, in
union with Christ's offering for us, as we proclaim
the mystery of faith.

body and blood of Christ, that we may be the
body of Christ, redeemed by His blood. By your
Spirit make us one with Christ, one with each
other, and one in ministry to the world, until
Christ comes in final victory, and we feast at his
heavenly banquet. Through your Son Jesus
Christ, with the Holy Spirit in your holy Church,
all honor and glory is Yours, Almighty Father,
now and forever more. Amen.

Today's Scripture
Luke 12:13-21 ESV

¹³Someone in the crowd said to him, "Teacher, tell my brother to divide the inheritance with me." ¹⁴But he said to him, "Man, who made me a judge or arbitrator over you?" ¹⁵And he said to them, "Take care, and be on your guard against all covetousness, for one's life does not consist in the abundance of his possessions." ¹⁶And he told them a parable, saying, "The land of a rich man produced plentifully, ¹⁷and he thought to himself, 'What shall I do, for I have nowhere to store my crops?' ¹⁸And he said, 'I will do this: I will tear down my barns and build larger ones, and there I will store all my grain and my goods.' ¹⁹And I will say to my soul, 'Soul, you have ample goods laid up for many years; relax, eat, drink, be merry.'" ²⁰But God said to him, 'Fool! This night your soul is required of you, and the things you have prepared, whose will they be?' ²¹So is the one who lays up treasure for himself and is not rich toward God."

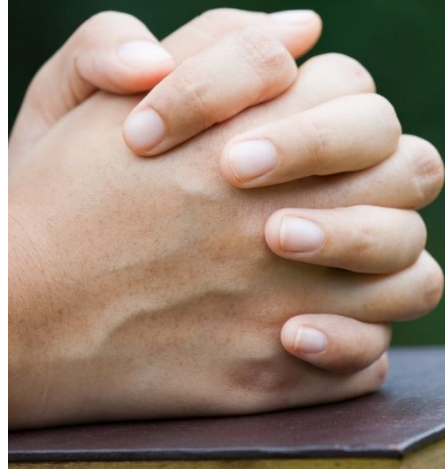
