- 1. Genesis 28:1-2 Isaac sets guardrails for Jacob's future spouse. What guardrails do you need for relationships and major decisions today?
- 2. Genesis 28:3-4, Ephesians 2:19 God's people become a company of peoples, the household of God. How can you help your group or family reflect this inclusive, covenant identity?
- 3. Genesis 28:6-9, Proverbs 14:12 Esau tries to "fix" things his own way. Why do you think we often try to "fix" our failures ourselves rather than simply repent and turn back to God?
- 4. Genesis 28:12, John 1:51 Jacob's dream points to Jesus as our true access to God. How does this reshape how you approach prayer and worship this week?
- 5. Genesis 28:15, Hebrews 13:5-6 God promises presence and protection. Where do you need to replace fear with trust because God is with you?
- 6. Genesis 28:16-19, Psalm 139:7-10 "Surely the Lord is in this place, and I did not know it." What practices help you grow in awareness of God's presence in ordinary moments?
- 7. Genesis 28:20-22, Titus 2:11-12 Grace leads Jacob to worship, vows, and generosity. What specific habit or act of generosity would express your response to grace right now?
