- 1. How does our personal unity with God impact our ability to be unified with others?
- 2. What does true unity with God look like? How is it different from simply identifying as a Christian or attending church?
- 3. Jesus submitted fully to the Father's will (Luke 22:42, John 5:19). What does it mean for us to submit fully to God in the same way?
- 4. Why do you think surrendering our will to God is so difficult? What are some areas where we struggle to let go?
- 5. Jesus prays that we would be "perfectly one" so that the world may believe (John 17:23). How does Christian unity serve as a witness to the world?
- 6. Philippians 2:3 tells us to count others as more significant than ourselves. What are some practical ways we can live this out in our relationships?
- 7. Paul mentions Epaphras "struggling" in prayer for others (Colossians 4:12-13). How does interceding for one another help strengthen unity?
- 8. How can you practically seek to build unity in the church or community this week?
