SMALL GROUP LEADER

The greatest need of every AWANA club is adults willing to serve as small group leaders. Without adult leaders, AWANA clubs aren't possible.

Leaders actively participate in all club segments alongside their assigned small group of kids/youth; building relationship and encouraging them to learn and understand handbook sections and Bible lessons in: Cubbies, Sparks, T&T, Trek or Journey.

STUDENT LEADER

Ages 12-18 yrs, are eligible to serve as Student Leaders in the kids clubs. JH Youth may serve in Cubbies or Sparks. HS Youth may serve in Cubbies, Sparks or T&T.

Student Leaders are paired with and assist adult leaders in small groups, games or worship.

GAMES LEADER

Assists the Games Director in leading the game time segments for Cubbies, Sparks and T&T.

WORSHIP LEADER

Assists in leading kids worship through music and motion during the large group time segments for Sparks and T&T.
