* Off to Camp:

Students need to be dropped off at the Church Campus on

* Packing List:

Camp can be hot during the summer time, so pack accordingly. Bring clothes that are comfortable enough to go from worship to physical rec. time. Be sure to label your students' sleeping bag, pillow, & towel. Pack extra shoes, towels, clothes that can get muddy, <u>Bible</u> & pen, Towel, toiletries (*deodorant!!!*), toothbrush, pajamas, plastic bag for muddy/wet things, lots of socks, swimsuit (appropriate), sunscreen, sunglasses, towel, sweatshirt for evenings, cash, . . . did we mention a towel? Oh, don't forget to bring your team color to wear during rec. (list being sent separately)! Note: luggage CANNOT be any larger than a carry-on bag; space is extremely limited & we have a bunch of students. A sleeping bag, pillow, carry-on bag, & small backpack are all that are allowed. IF WE RUN OUT OF SPACE, THE BIGGEST LUGGAGE WILL BE LEFT BEHIND!

* Cash @ Camp:

There will be a few things that your student may want to bring extra cash for, these are completely optional. There is a camp store that offers snacks, gifts, books, & t-shirts. <u>Please DO NOT send excessive spending money</u> (no \$100 bills, please); they usually purchase an extreme amount of sweets that isn't good for anyone. :) Remind your student to keep track of their belongings & money.
