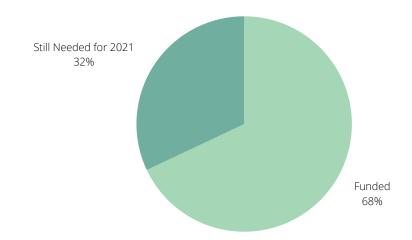
Revenue and Support

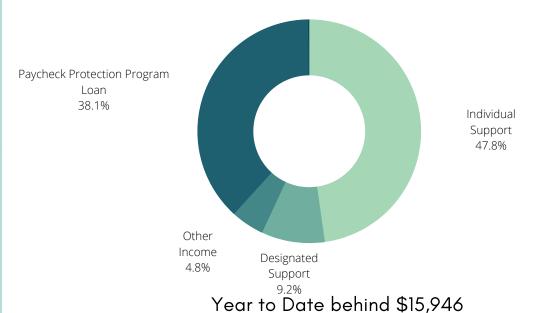
Individual Support comes in the form of Electronic Giving (Sharefaith and ACH withdrawals from banks). It also comes by mailin and offering plate checks and cash.
