REVEALED: GOD'S BIG FINISH 5 WEEK SERIES

This powerful five week series will take children on an exciting journey through the final book of the Bible—Revelation. With vibrant imagery, heavenly worship, and the promise of Jesus' return, kids will discover that God's story ends with hope, victory, and joy for those who follow Him. Each week focuses on a different theme: from Jesus as King to the new heaven and earth, children will see how God's plan ends with Jesus reigning forever—and us with Him!

Hook for Children: *What if you got a peek into Heaven? What if you saw angels singing, trumpets blasting, and Jesus riding a white horse, with His name written as 'King of kings and Lord of lords'? That's what the book of Revelation is all about: Where we'll uncover amazing visions, promises and truths that show us how powerful Jesus is—and how much he loves us. This is God's BIG Finish, and you're invited to be part of it!*

Week 1: Jesus is King

- Bible Story: "Jesus Rules Forever" - Revelation 1:4-18
- Gospel Connection: Jesus isn't just a character in a story—He's the living King who died for us and rose again so we could be with Him forever. When we say "yes" to Jesus, we become part of His kingdom.

Week 2: The Throne Room

- Bible Story: "God is Holy" - Revelation 4:1-11
- Gospel Connection: God is powerful and perfect—and yet, because of Jesus, we are welcomed into His presence. Jesus is the Lamb who gave His life to save us. Because of Him, we get to join the angels and all creation in worshipping our holy God.

Week 3: The Battle Belongs to God

- Bible Story: "God Wins Over Evil" - Revelation 12 + 19
- Gospel Connection: Sin and evil don't get the last word—Jesus does. Because of His victory on the cross, we don't have to be afraid. When we trust in Jesus, His victory becomes our victory too.

Week 4: A New Heaven and Earth

- Bible Story: "God is Making Everything New" - Revelation 21:1-5
- Gospel Connection: God promises to make everything new—and that includes us. Because of Jesus, we are forgiven, made clean, and given the promise of eternal life in God's perfect forever home.

Week 5: Come, Lord Jesus!

- Bible Story: "Jesus is Coming Back" - Revelation 22
- Gospel Connection: The story of the Bible ends with hope—Jesus is coming back! And because of the gospel, we can live ready and excited. When we follow Jesus, we're part of His family now and forever. One day, He'll return to make everything right—and we'll be with Him forever.



REJOICE! 4 WEEK SERIES

The REJOICE curriculum invites children to explore the profound joy of knowing Jesus - a joy that transcends temporary happiness. Over four weeks, students will discover how the birth of Jesus brings a deep, lasting joy applicable to all life circumstances. Children will learn to differentiate between "right now" happiness and "never-ending" joy through engaging Bible stories, interactive activities, and thoughtful discussions.

Hook for Children: *Did you know you can receive the most greatest gift of all? God's love came in human form at the birth of Jesus Christ. Through His life, death, and resurrection, we can receive forgiveness for our sins and the gift of eternal life. This good news imparts a joy that surpasses temporary happiness, providing a reason to rejoice even in challenging times. As we believe in Jesus and nurture our relationship with Him, we can experience this profound, lasting joy and share it with others, regardless of our circumstances*

Week 6: Rejoice in Hope

- Bible Story: 'The Prophecy of Jesus' Birth - Isaiah 9:6-7, Luke 1:26-38
- Gospel Connection: Because Jesus brings hope, we can have joy even when waiting for good things. Jesus fulfills God's promises, giving us hope for salvation and a joyful future with Him.

Week 7: Rejoice in Peace

- Bible Story: "Journey to Bethel and Jesus' Birth - Luke 2:1-7)
- Gospel Connection: Because Jesus brings peace, we can have joy even when things around us are scary. Through Jesus, we can have peace with God and find calm joy in any situation

Week 8: Rejoice in Love

- Bible Story: "Shepherds Visit Jesus" - Luke 2:15-20
- Gospel Connection: Because Jesus brings love, we can have joy knowing we are always cared for, no matter what. God's love, demonstrated through Jesus, invites us into a joyful relationship with Him.

Week 9: Rejoice Always!

- Bible Story: "Simeon and Anna Rejoice" - Luke 2:25-38
- Gospel Connection: Because of Jesus, we can choose joy in all circumstances and share it with others. The good news of Jesus' birth brings a joy that transforms our lives and inspires us to always rejoice.

Week 10: Grace Kids Christmas Party

- Let's finish off our #BESTYEAREVER by celebrating the good things He has done and rejoice this Christmas as we party together!

Week 11: Grace Christmas Community Service
