Far from being the mysterious, incomprehensible book many imagine it to be, the purpose of **the book of Revelation** is to reveal truth, not to obscure it. That fact is evident in its title, "The Revelation of Jesus Christ" (1:1), primarily in His second coming glory. *Apokalupsis* ("Revelation") could be translated "an uncovering," "an unveiling," or "a disclosure." Our objective in looking at **the first seven chapters of this book** is to consider "The Beginning of the End" and therefore live a purposeful life, where we begin with the end in mind.
