

## **CoreGroup Coach Ministry Description**

**Purpose:** CoreGroups are our primary spiritual formation program. We believe that CoreGroups are our best tool for life transformation within our congregation.

- 70% of average weekly worship attendance will be participating in CoreGroups

**Values:** We value accessibility, flexibility, and visibility over structure and content

**Time**: 2-4 hours a month

## **Description**

Every layer of this ministry including leader, coaches, directors, pastors, and staff will champion and advocate CoreGroups and Explore. A CG Coach manages and shepherds CG Leaders. The role is split 50/50 between managing and leading. **Managing**: Helps to manage the details that go into creating a great small group experience. Details and logistics. **Shepherding**: Cares for leaders, listens to their stories, knows the name of their pet, cares about their job changes, new babies, and big moves. Takes care of them before they show up to take care of others. Key tasks include:

- Prays for group leaders weekly
- Commits to raising up new leaders and coaches.
- Communicates with group leaders once a month
  - Ocllect and share data (who's in your group, how many in your group, who's left? Any changes such as day, time, location, leader.
    - Recommendation: Meet with your 3 leaders at one time as a group (in person or virtual).
- Attends quarterly training events.

## What you can expect from The CoreGroup Lead Team

Prioritize investing in you with time, training and care/belonging.

- Train everyone so that they are better equipped at what they do.
- Provide weekly curriculum
- Cast and re-cast vision of groups
- Cue leaders and coaches to connect with new and next leaders and coaches
