Bible Story

Supplies Needed: Bible Story Pictures (provided on pg. 5-8)

Teacher Instruction: Before class begins, print the Bible Story Pictures. Have the children gathered around so they can see the pictures.

Say- Jesus was at a banquet dinner at the home of a Pharisee. (*show pic*) The Pharisees were the religious leaders of the time.

Say- They always invited Jesus to their gatherings to try to trap Him into saying something wrong.

Say- While Jesus was at the banquet, He noticed that many of the people were trying to sit in the best seats at the table. (*show pic*)

Say- They did this because those were the “important seats.” They wanted people to think they were very important people.

Say- Jesus noticed people trying to get the best seats, so... (*show pic*)

Say- He said, “Don’t sit in the seat of honor. Instead, take the lowest seat.”

Say- Jesus was saying they should let others take the better seats.

Say- Then Jesus said something REALLY important - (*show pic*) “For those who exalt themselves will be humbled, and those who humble themselves will be exalted.”

Say- Jesus was saying that if you try to make yourself #1, you will probably embarrass yourself.

Say- Instead, we should put others first. When we put others first, God is very proud!

Say- Putting others first is called being HUMBLE. Say that with me, “HUMBLE!” (*Say the word aloud with the kids*)

Say- We should follow the example of Jesus by serving others and being humble!

Hands-On Learning

Supplies Needed: Sunglasses, Play Money, Costume Jewelry

Teacher Instruction: Before class begins, gather classroom materials. Have the children gathered around so they can see any illustration materials.

Say- I brought all my fanciest stuff with me today. Once I put these things on, I will be better than all of you.

-Put on the glasses and jewelry and pretend to fan yourself with the money-

Say (in a dramatic and snobby way)- Look at me! I am so rich, and so famous, and so special, and so important. I am SO much better than everyone else.

Ask- Does that sound like how God wants us to treat others?

-Allow time for the kids to respond; Remove the glasses and jewelry and lay down the money as the kids respond-

Say- You are absolutely right! That is NOT how God wants us to treat others.

Say- God wants us to be HUMBLE. Say that with me, HUMBLE! *(Say the word aloud with the kids)*

Say- Humble means I put others first.

Say- Remember the people fighting over the best seats in our Bible story? They did NOT put others first. Uh oh!

Say- Instead, Jesus taught them to be HUMBLE. He didn't try to take the best seat for Himself.

Say- Jesus let others go first. He let others be special, and He let others be important.

Say- Jesus served others! When we serve others, it shows that we are humble.

Say- If we want to be like Jesus, we must serve and be HUMBLE!

Say- I will say NO to pride and be HUMBLE! Say that with me! *(Say the phrase aloud with the kids)*



Craft #1: Bible Story Coloring Page

Supplies Needed: Bible Story Coloring Page Print Piece (provided on pg. 9); Crayons or markers

Teacher Instruction: Before class begins, print the Bible Story Coloring Page Print Piece. Make sure you have enough for each kid to have one. Gather the classroom materials as well. Have the kids sit in an area that is appropriate for coloring.

How To Do Craft - Kids can color freely as they choose.



Craft #2: H Is For Humble Craft

Supplies Needed: H Is For Humble Craft Print Piece (provided on pg. 10); Crayons or markers; Stickers; Stamps

Teacher Instruction: Before class begins, print the H Is For Humble Craft Print Pieces. Make sure you have enough craft pages for each kid to have one. Gather the classroom materials as well. Have the kids sit in an area that is appropriate for crafting.

How To Do Craft - Allow the kids to decorate the craft page using stickers and stamps. As you help with the craft, talk about how we should serve others and be humble!



Craft #3: Serve & Be Humble Coloring Page

Supplies Needed: Serve & Be Humble Coloring Page Print Piece (provided on pg. 11); Crayons or markers

Teacher Instruction: Before class begins, print the Serve & Be Humble Coloring Page Print Pieces. Make sure you have enough for each kid to have one. Gather the classroom materials as well. Have the kids sit in an area that is appropriate for coloring.

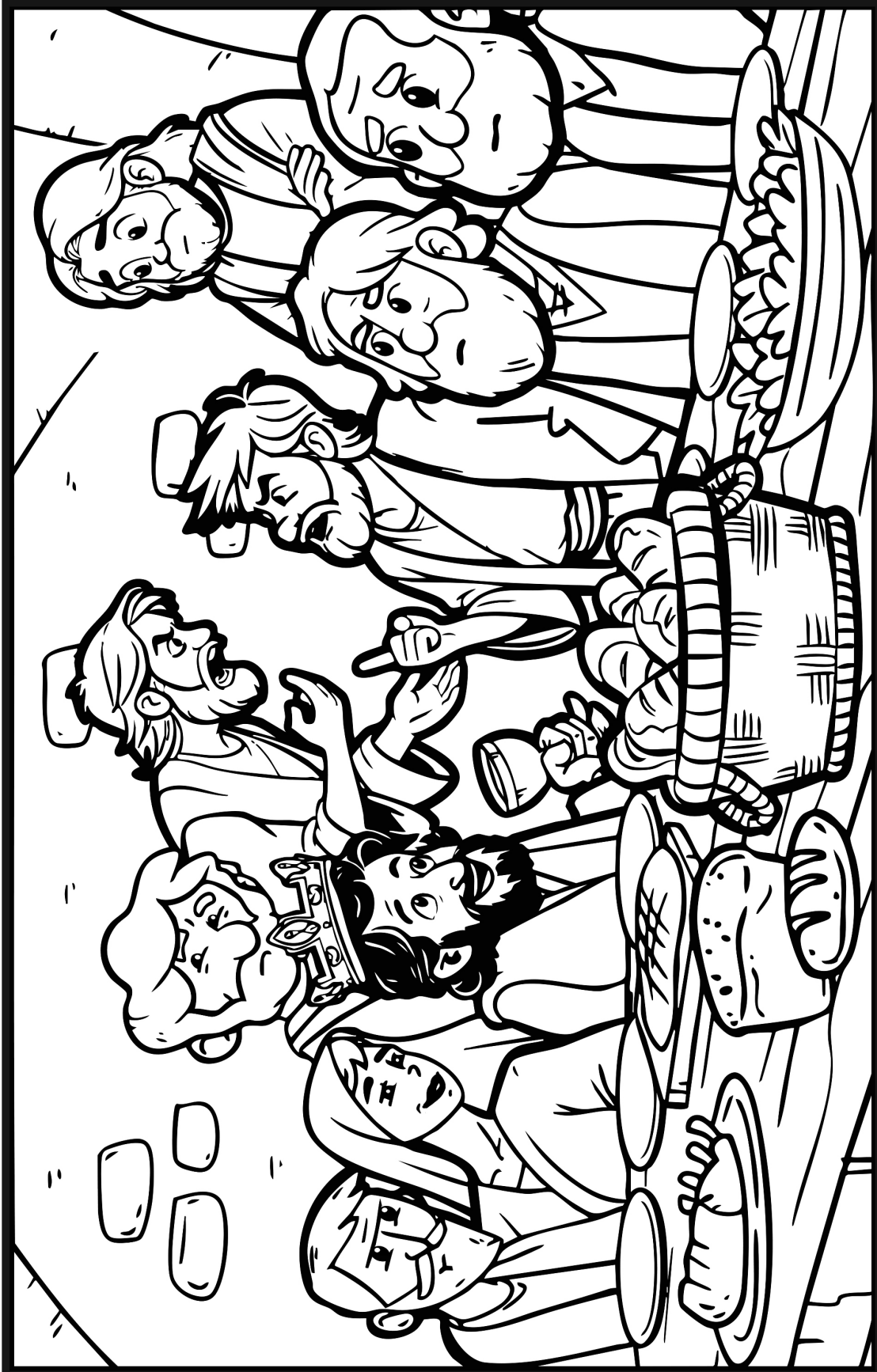

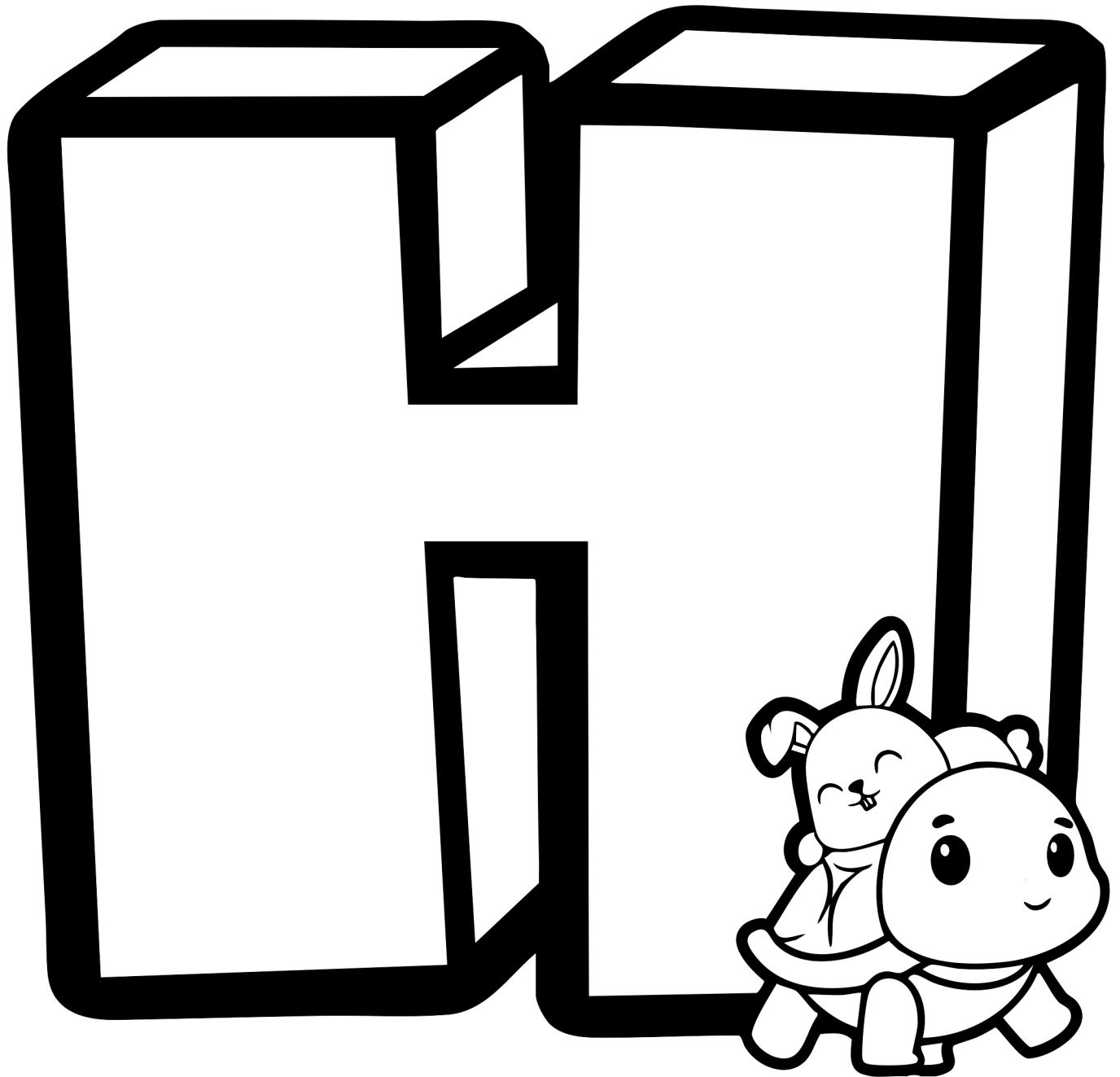
