Supplies Needed: Bible Story Pictures (provided on pg. 5-8)

Teacher Instruction: Before class begins, print the Bible Story Pictures. Have the children gathered around so they can see the pictures.

- **Say-** Abraham was a man who loved God very much. God spoke to Abraham and said, "Abraham, I want you to sacrifice your son, Isaac." (show picture)
- **Say-** This was usually done with lambs and sheep, not people! Abraham loved his son, Isaac, and hearing this news made him very sad.
- **Say-** If Abraham sacrificed Isaac, he would lose his son. If he didn't sacrifice Isaac, he would be disobeying God.
- **Say-** Abraham chose to obey God. He took Isaac up a nearby mountain. (show picture)
- **Say-** On the way up the mountain, Isaac noticed they didn't bring a lamb. He asked Abraham, "Father, how are we going to perform a sacrifice without a lamb?" (show picture)
- **Say-** Abraham told Isaac, "God will provide a lamb for the sacrifice."
- **Say-** When they got to the top of the mountain, Abraham placed Isaac on the altar. Abraham was ready to obey God.
- **Say-** Suddenly, an angel called out to Abraham. "Abraham, STOP!" (show picture)
- Say- The angel told Abraham, "Because you have obeyed me, I will bless you richly."
- **Say-** Just then, Abraham looked over at a nearby bush. God provided a lamb caught in the bush—this became the sacrifice. Wow!
- **Say-** Was it easy for Isaac to obey his father and get on the altar? No! Was it any easier for Abraham to obey his Heavenly Father and sacrifice his own son? Not at all! Abraham and Isaac both honored and obeyed, so God blessed them!
- **Say-** When you honor and obey your parents, you are also obeying God, and you will be blessed!

Supplies Needed: A few toys

Teacher Instruction: Before class begins, gather classroom materials. Have the children gathered around so they can see any illustration materials.

- **Say-** Families are SO important to God. He wants our families to be HEALTHY. Say "healthy" with me! (Say the word aloud with the kids)
- **Say-** The Bible says, "Honor your father and mother..." We don't say the word "honor" all the time. So, what does it mean? Think of it this way...
- **Ask-** Do you have something that is very special to you? Maybe a favorite toy, a blankie, or a stuffed animal you love more than your other toys? (Show the toys, holding them as you teach)

-Allow time for response-

Ask- How do you treat that special toy or lovie?

-Allow time for response-

- **Say-** That's right! You are gentle with your toy; treat it with love and do your best to keep it safe.
- Say- That is A LOT like honor. God gave us moms and dads as a special gift. They are like God's present to us!
- **Say-** We should honor our mom & dad by being gentle with them, showing them love, and using kind words. Those things show HONOR to our mom and dad.
- **Say-** God also wants us to OBEY our parents, but it's not always easy.
- **Say-** It can be tough to obey when your mom asks for help, and you're playing with toys.
- **Say-** It can be tough to obey when your dad says it's bedtime, and you REALLY don't want to go to bed because you're watching something on TV.
- **Say-** It's not always easy to obey, but God wants us to obey our moms and dads even when it's not easy! And guess what? God can help us obey our parents when we ask for His help.
- **Say-** When we HONOR and OBEY our moms and dads, we HONOR and OBEY God too! Wow, that's cool!
- **Say-** Let's say this together: "I will honor and obey. I will do what my parents say!" (Say the phrase aloud with the kids)



Craft #1: Bible Story Coloring Page

Supplies Needed: Bible Story Coloring Page Print Piece (provided on pg. 9); Crayons or markers

Teacher Instruction: Before class begins, print the Bible Story Coloring Page Print Piece. Make sure you have enough for each kid to have one. Gather the classroom materials as well. Have the kids sit in an area that is appropriate for coloring.

Teacher Instruction: Before class begins, print the Honor & Obey Tracing Craft Print Pieces. Make sure you have enough craft pages for each kid to have one. Gather the classroom materials as well. Have the kids sit in an area that is appropriate for crafting.

How To Do Craft - Allow the kids to trace the dotted designs using crayons or markers. As you help the kids with the craft, talk about honoring and obeying your parents!





Craft #3: I Will Honor & Obey Coloring Page


Supplies Needed: I Will Honor & Obey Coloring Page Print Piece (provided on pg. 11); Crayons or markers



How To Do Craft - Kids can color freely as they choose.







