Bible Story

Supplies Needed: Bible Story Pictures (provided on pg. 5-8)

Teacher Instruction: Before class begins, print the Bible Story Pictures. Have the children gathered around so they can see the pictures.

Say- When we left Moses in our last Bible Story, he had made a terrible mistake. He didn't wait for God's plan, hurt an Egyptian, got in trouble with Pharaoh, and ran for his life into the desert.

Say- Many years passed. Moses grew older. He got married, started a family and began working as a shepherd, taking care of sheep.

Say- One day, he was out taking care of his sheep. Moses looked in the distance (*show pic*) to see what looked like a bush on fire. Moses wasn't sure why, but it seemed like the bush was on fire, but never burned up.

Say- He decided to have a closer look. (*show pic*) When Moses got close, a voice came out of the bush saying, "Moses! Moses! Take off your sandals, you are standing on holy ground."

Ask- Who do you think this was speaking to Moses?

-Allow time for responses-

Say- That's right! It was God. (*show pic*) So, Moses took his sandals off and bowed down with his face toward the ground. He knew that he was in the presence of God.

Say- God had not forgotten Moses. He knew exactly where Moses was the whole time. (*show pic*)

Say- God spoke from the burning bush. He said to Moses, "I have seen the suffering of my people in Egypt. I am sending you to lead them to freedom."

Say- Remember, God's people had been held captive as slaves in Egypt for over 400 years. God was calling Moses to go and lead them to freedom. Isn't that amazing? God had not forgotten Moses. He still had a plan for Moses' life.

Say- God did not forget Moses, and He will not forget you!

Hands-On Learning

Supplies Needed: *Completed Flower Craft*

Teacher Instruction: *Before class begins, gather classroom materials. Have the children gathered around so they can see any illustration materials.*

Say- Look at the beautiful flowers you made today! *(Show the completed flower craft)*

Say- These are called Forget Me Not flowers. Isn't that a sweet name?

Say- People grow Forget Me Not flowers to help them remember someone special. And guess what? These flowers can help us remember something really, really important...

Say- God will never forget me!

Ask- Have you ever felt forgotten before? How did that feel?

-Allow time for responses-

Say- Moses might have felt forgotten. He was probably sad and maybe thought God was done with him.

Say- But God hadn't forgotten Moses—not even for one moment! God showed up in a burning bush and said, “Moses! I have something important for you to do!” Wow!

Say- God still had a plan for Moses, and He has a plan for you, too.

Say- Sometimes we might feel a little lonely or left out. Maybe a friend doesn't want to play, or we have a bad day and feel sad.

Say- But even on those days, God remembers you. He sees you. He loves you!

Say- You are never alone, because God is always with you. He doesn't need a Forget Me Not flower to remember you.

Say- God made you; He loves you and has GREAT BIG plans for your life!

Say- Say this with me: “God will never forget me!” *(Say the phrase along with the kids)*



Craft #1: Bible Story Coloring Page

Supplies Needed: Bible Story Coloring Page Print Piece (provided on pg. 9); Crayons or markers

Teacher Instruction: Before class begins, print the Bible Story Coloring Page Print Piece. Make sure you have enough for each kid to have one. Gather the classroom materials as well. Have the kids sit in an area that is appropriate for coloring.

How To Do Craft - Kids can color freely as they choose.



Craft #2: Flower Craft

Supplies Needed: Flower Craft Print Piece (provided on pg. 10); Crayons or Markers; Scissors; Glue; Craft Sticks; Cardstock

Teacher Instruction: Before class begins, print the Flower Craft Print Pieces. This will work best if printed on cardstock. Make sure you have enough craft pages for each kid to have one. Gather the classroom materials as well. Have the kids sit in an area that is appropriate for crafting.

How To Do Craft - Allow the kids to decorate the flower craft page using crayons or markers. Cut out the flowers and glue them to the top of a craft stick. The craft stick will act as the stem, so encourage the kids to color it green! As you help the kids with the craft, remind them that God will never forget them.



Craft #3: Bunny Coloring Page

Supplies Needed: Bunny Coloring Page Print Piece (provided on pg. 11); Crayons or markers

Teacher Instruction: Before class begins, print the Bunny Coloring Page Print Pieces. Make sure you have enough for each kid to have one. Gather the classroom materials as well. Have the kids sit in an area that is appropriate for coloring.

How To Do Craft - Kids can color freely as they choose.



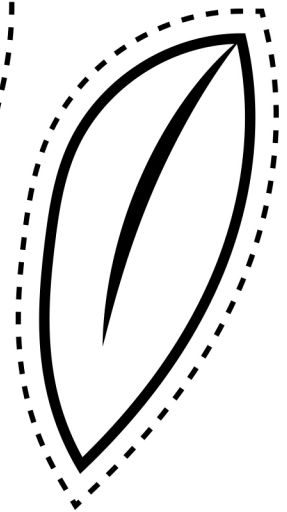
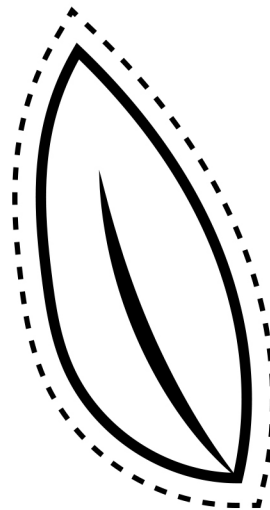
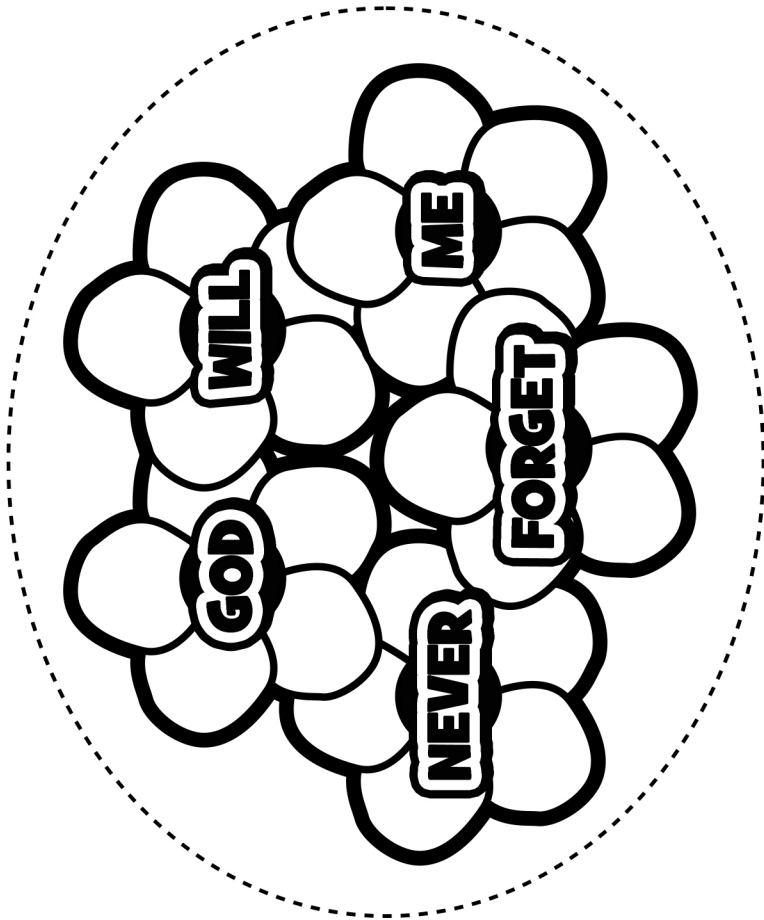
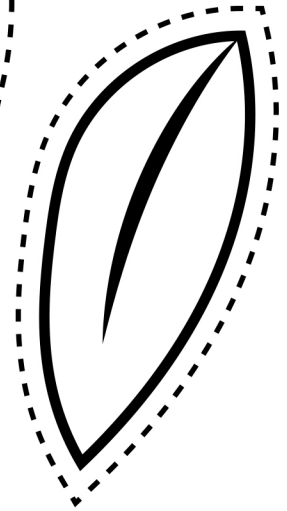
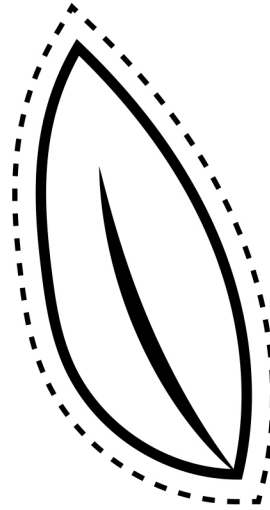
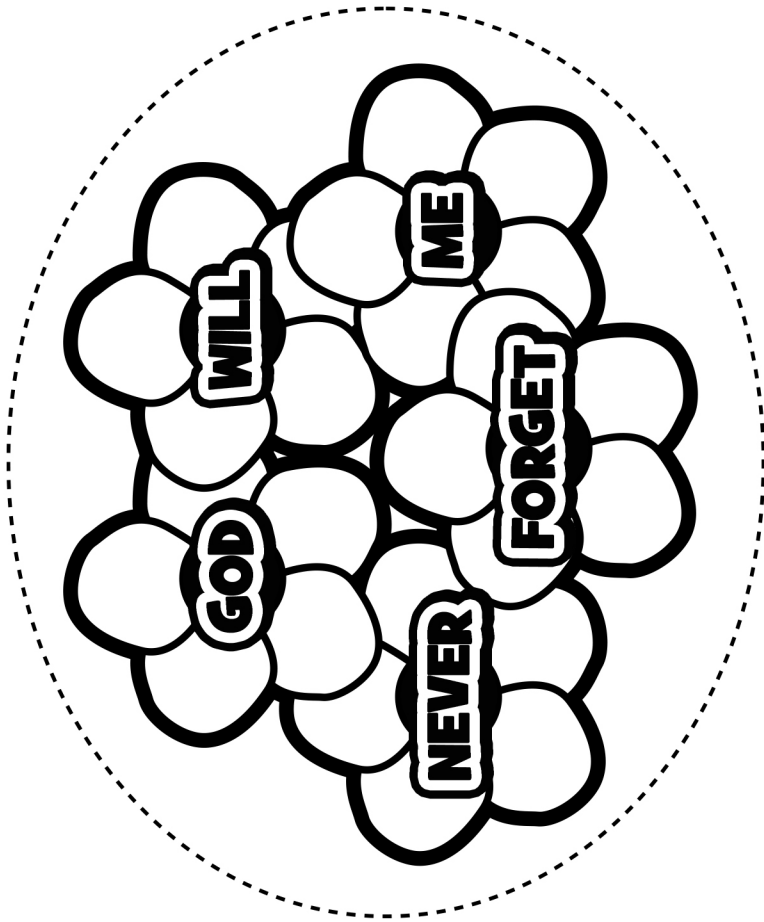


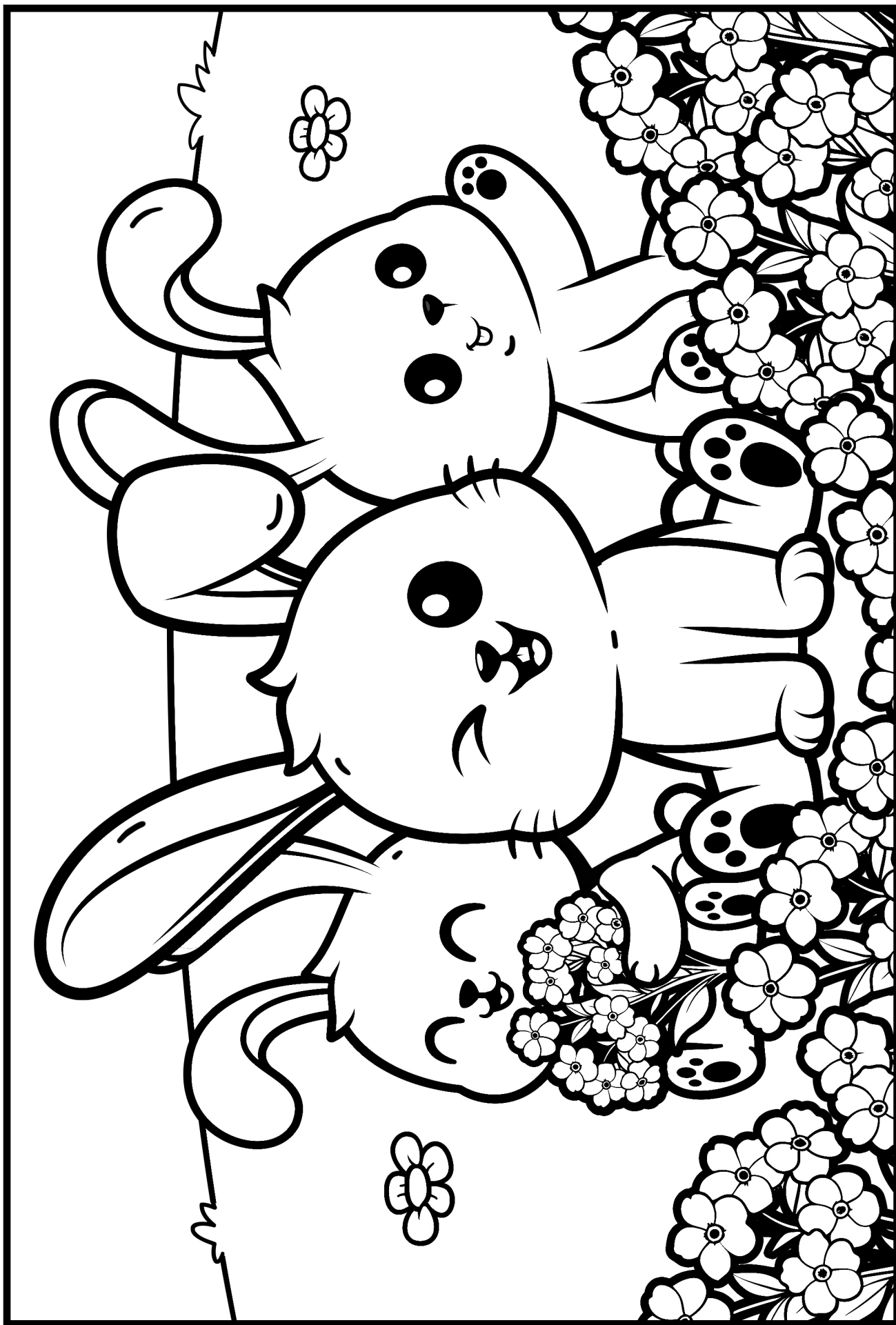
