The Word Became Flesh - (v. 14)

- The Word "became" one of us Philippians 2:5-11; 1 John 1:1-4
- But Why?
 - Jesus was incarnated to die 1 John 3:8
 - Jesus was incarnated to sympathize with humanity Hebrews 4:15
 - o Jesus was incarnated to show us how to live as children of God
 - 2 Corinthians 8:9

The Word Tabernacled With Us - (v. 14)

- A Person NOT a place
 - o A better temple prophesied Malachi 3:1; Haggai 2:9
 - A better temple fulfilled Matthew 12:6
 - A new Heaven and Earth with one temple Revelation 21:22-27
- A Person in whom we abide
 - The OT tabernacle was about God abiding with His people
 - Exodus 25:8-9; 29:45-46
 - The Incarnation brought God with us Matthew 1:23
- A Glory to behold
 - Moses longed to God's glory Exodus 33:18-23
 - Jesus is the glory of God 2 Corinthians 4:6

- The incarnation explains the gospel
- The Law and grace Romans 7:12-13; Galatians 4:4-5
