The Holiness Of God
Isaiah 6:1-13

Main idea: When we encounter the Lord of glory, His calling on our lives brings first cleansing then a commission. Jesus Christ alone is our only hope; Worship Him.

The Context Before The Encounter - (v. 1)

- Uzziah died, but I saw the Lord!

The Encounter With The Lord's Presence - (vv. 1-3)

- Who were these attendants? - **1 Kings 22:19**
- What were doing? - **Psalms 72:19**
- What did the declare?

The Response To The Lord's Presence - (vv. 3-5)

- The first response; the temple foundations
- The second response; man

The Response Of The Lord To Isaiah - (vv. 6-7)

- The angelic attendants begin preparation
- Forgiveness and cleansing - **1 John 1:7-9**

The Response Of Isaiah To The Lord - (v. 8)

- Who will go for us?
- I will go

The Reception Of The Lord's Message - (vv. 9-12)

- The message will be rejected
- How long will I have to give a message that people ignore?
- Until they are broken, they will never listen

The Hope Of The Lord's Message - (v. 13)

- The Lord's people will not be removed
- The stump of the Lord will bloom again - **Isaiah 11:1-13; 12**
