Main idea: Kingdom entrance is granted to those who have lived their lives oriented around knowing their King intimately and faithfully obeying His will. Many who think they are saved will be declared unrighteous and rejected from entrance to His forever kingdom.

The Kingdom Entrance Is Narrow - (v. 21)

- Intellectual knowledge is essential, but insufficient to save
 - Not everyone who says, Lord, Lord! Romans 10:9-11; James 2:18

- Intimate knowledge is required 1 Peter 1:3-5; Romans 10:14-17
- Intimate knowledge pursues God will
 - Ephesians 6:6; 1 Thessalonians 5:14-18
 - Matthew 12:50; Hebrews 2:11; John 17:2-3
