Job Duties and Responsibilities:

- Comply with COTR Children's Ministry Policies and Procedures and COTR Sitters Handbook
- Cultivate a culture where parents are confident that their children are in a safe place
- Create and maintain an engaging and fun atmosphere where kids not only learn about Jesus, but they are shown Jesus in the classroom
- Utilize all supplies and materials set-up for lesson plans
- Follow classroom schedule diligently
- Maintain care for classroom cleanliness
- Perform other duties as assigned
- This is a part-time + flexibility position (shifts are chosen by employee)

General Skills, Qualifications, and Physical Requirements:

- Love Jesus, love kids
- Be approachable, confident and "smart" with people
- A positive and patient attitude
- Team player, exhibit a positive attitude and willingness to help COTR staff and members
- Ability to sit or stand for long periods of time
- The employee must frequently lift and/or move up to 10 lbs. and occasionally lift and/or move up to 25 lbs.

- Maintain a strong personal relationship with God
- Use integrity while off campus; your integrity is a reflection of the church
- Be an active member of COTR by attending and supporting the weekend church services
- Commit to the 10 Cultural Responsibilities of COTR

- Possess the ability to self-motivate and manage time well; being proficient in meeting deadlines/timelines
- Be punctual to shifts and stay for duration of shifts
- Request and communicate to your oversight on schedule changes in a timely manner
