MINISTRY: SOZO SOLUTIONS

FOREIGN PARTNERS

MINISTRY: NEW LIFE CHILDREN'S HOME, GUATEMALA

NLCH in Villa Nueva, Guatemala is a refuge and a safe haven for orphaned, abandoned and abused children. Our passion and purpose are the nourishment and healing of mind, body and soul for children in crisis. The provide love, safety, shelter, food, medical care, education, recreation, discipleship and a family in which to belong.

Project Goal: \$10,000

Project Purpose: These funds will be used to provide Christmas gifts and school supplies for the children at the home.

NEW VISION PROJECTS (CON'T)

MINISTRY: MISSION OF HOPE, DOMINICAN REPUBLIC/HAITI

As an organization following Jesus Christ, we exist to bring life transformation to every man, woman, and child. We do this through church advancement, education and food security.

Project Goal: \$100,000 - \$300,000

Project Purpose:

There are three current projects that each cost \$100,000.

- Warehouse at Jarbacoa, DR Campus: The project will allow MOH to expand
 their meal packing program for those in need in the DR, with the vision of
 one day packing DR resourced grain and sending it to Haiti as well as meet
 the needs in the DR. It will also allow visiting teams to pack meals to take
 out with them to help the local church meet the needs in their communities.
- Two new vehicles for DR Team: MOH currently have 3 cars from Haiti that have to go back to Haiti by law. MOH needs to raise the funds to buy two new vehicles in the DR that will be used to do ministry through the country.
- **Ship 1 million meals to Haiti:** This is the greatest need in Haiti right now and is the number one thing pastors are requesting to help their people. This is the front edge for MOH to meet needs and share the Gospel.

MINISTRY: TONY & CARRIE TAYLOR, GLORY RANCH RETREAT CENTER, GUATEMALA

Glory Ranch exists to provide a place of rest and encouragement for pastors and their families.

Project Goal: \$35,000

Project Purpose:

These funds would be used to purchase property in order to expand Glory Ranch Retreat Center.





ONGOING VISION PROJECTS

Our total giving for the 2024/2025 budget year will exceed \$360,00.00.

SHORT-TERM MISSION TRIPS:

Pursue Missions will send 144 people on a short-term mission thrip in 2025. We have two domestic trips, and 12 foreign trips scheduled for 2025.

PURSUE MISSIONS BANQUET:

This year's Pursue Missions Banquet will be dedicated to raising support for Bob and Chrissy Godwin, career missionaries serving in Estonia. The Godwin's have a long and impactful history in missions, having spent two decades in Mongolia before transitioning to Estonia ten years ago. Their ministry in Estonia focuses on vital work in church planting, discipleship and leadership development.

Estonia is known as the least religious nation in Eastern Europe. The purpose of this banquet is to raise funds for their new church plant in Tabasalu, Estonia.
