What do you study?
The Bible. Our adult Life Groups use a curriculum from LifeWay called Explore the Bible. We study one book of the Bible per guarter, alternating between

the Old and New Testaments.

How long does a Life Group last? Life Groups are one hour long. This includes Bible study as well as prayers, praises, and fellowship.

What do I do with my kids?
On Sunday mornings they are in a Life Group too! Kids from nursery to 12th Grade are in age appropriate Life Groups. Village Kids Jr., Village Kids, and Village Student Ministries all work to study the Bible.

Do husbands and wives go to class together?

At The Village Baptist Church we have co-ed Life Groups for married and single adults. Additionally we have Men's and Women's Bible studies that meet throughout the week. Whatever your preference, there's something available for you!

How big is a Life Group? Most Life Groups are between 10-20 people, some are smaller and a few are larger.

What if I don't know anything about the Bible?

You don't have to! The primary focus of our Life Groups are to grow in their understanding of the Bible together.


WHY SHOULD I ATTEND A LIFE GROUP?
