What is Shiloh?

Shiloh Christian Children's Ranch is a not-for-profit Christian organization, in Missouri, that is 100% privately funded and has a mission to provide Christian homes for abused/neglected children without any fee or charge. In this way, Shiloh meets the spiritual, emotional, social, physical, and educational needs of each child. Shiloh youth are taught to care for younger children as part of their preparation for life. An estimated 1.35 million children in the U.S. are homeless. Every day in this country, more than 3 children die as a result of abuse and neglect. Every 10 seconds a child is abused.



Who can come?

We're promoting the trip to Junior High & High School students. However, anyone is welcome to carpool down and join us. Please let us know you're coming! **Everyone must submit a complete "Medical Release Form" to go on the trip.**

3. Everyone needs a change of pace. This trip will give you a healthy opportunity to do something else and disconnect from electronics to connect with friends!
4. It's good for anyone to spend time focusing on serving others! Our God's heart's desire is for you to be His hands and feet by selflessly serving and loving people the way He did.
5. You're love for God will grow as you join Him in serving others, listen to people share their testimonies (stories, and participate in devotional/worship times with the group).

This trip isn't focused on our comfort or entertainment like most trips are.

This trip is about learning to serve and love others as Jesus did.

What kind of projects will we do?

Short answer...we will do farm type jobs. In the past we have done grounds work, landscaping, chopping-collecting-stacking firewood, chicken-harvesting, gravel work, wiring, installed shelving, roofing, painted rooms, installed fencing, and cleaned out barns. We will be working hard every day, most of the day. What kind of projects we do depends on how many people we have, what the weather ends up being, and what their needs are. **I like to say, "This trip will be an adventure. I can't predict everything. I can't control everything. So more than anything I need from you a willingness to dive in and do whatever the situation demands - and do it with a great attitude."**

10 Item Packing List:

1. **Servant's heart & attitude!**
2. **Sleeping Bag/Bedding & Pillow:** they will have beds with a mattress to lay sleeping bags on
3. **Bathing Items:** deodorant, toothbrush and paste, body wash, etc.
4. **Towel:** This is important! May need two.
5. **Swimming Suit:** If they want to swim in the pond.
6. **Work Clothes:** They will need to bring clothes to work in. They will get dirty.
7. **Boots/Shoes:** for walking in mud.
8. **Gloves:** for working & carrying wood.
9. **Physical Bible:** for devotions and prayer times.
10. **Extra Money:** For gas station snacks or arcade games at Malibu Jacks.

Youth will be able to bring and check their phones. They will not be allowed to play on them for very long. Adults will hold them during projects. We're not responsible for your items.
