And it honors God when we love and value people enough to pour ourselves into our relationships.

(Jesus), we see God's desire for our relationships and how we can strengthen our connections with the people closest to us. Starting Christmas Eve and continuing through January, our sermon series "You + Me = We" will dig into God's Word for practical help to cultivate strong, healthy connections in our daily lives.

The title of the series, "You + Me = We", encapsulates the essence of relationships by recognizing that a relationship's strength is in the unity and partnership of people, even in the face of challenges. And when we are better at our relationships, we will have better relationships. #### The August and Mildred Bernthal Scholarship Fund

Pastor August and Mildred Bernthal left a legacy to our school by first starting Grace Lutheran School and then establishing a scholarship fund. They wanted to be sure that members of Grace who wished to enroll their children in the school could do it even if they faced financial barriers. Many people have benefited from this fund over the years - until recently. Now, because of the State of Florida's Step-Up program, any child can attend Grace! But with a greater and more varied population at our school, new problems have emerged. There are students who are struggling in school and need some extra help. To address this problem, the school started an after-school tutoring program. High quality tutors are available to address the skills the students need help with; however, this help comes at a cost that many of our families cannot afford. Grace's School Board has decided to add another purpose to the scholarship fund – to supplement the cost of tutoring. Also, if a child needs academic testing for a learning disability, this fund can help parents pay for the cost of that testing.

So, if you have ever given to this fund know that it will continue to enrich the students of our school. If you have never given before, consider a donation to help us in its new expanded purpose.
