A list of what YOU have helped us accomplish February 2023 – February 2024

- 168 commitments representing a 50% increase in annual commitments made
- Purchased existing building, 330 Ave. C, SE, instead of incurring rising construction costs of building a new building to house 10 classrooms.
- Construction of underground retention ponds with storm check chambers under pavement.
- Construction of new parking lot
- Repaving and striping of existing school parking lot
- New sidewalk surrounding parking lot
- Side entry pavers to the sanctuary
- Pre-school playground relocated with new equipment
- New landscaping on 4th street and Ave. C in front of sanctuary
- Replacement of all plumbing supply lines and irrigation piping on Ave. C side of school
- Development of a 40-Day Devotional Booklet with devotions written by members, staff and faculty of Grace.
- 10,000 "Cross in My Pocket" crosses given by members to those in our community and beyond
- Secured campus with electronic locking doors
- Generosity increase of 50% (in giving) compared to previous years
