One Day Closer

"Pastor, I'm one day closer." That's what a member said to me on the way out of church one day. This statement is actually a very good perspective for all of us to have, especially when we are running a race in which we can't quite see when the end will be. (Don't miss the story of the family a few paragraphs down.)

In the month of May, many students (and teachers, too!) are looking forward to the end of the school year. Our *Endure* theme will finally come to an end, but it won't yet be *The End*. Thus, we will need to keep *ENDuring*. Yes, the word "end" is included in "endure." Endure is continuing to patiently persevere. At the same time, endure assumes there will be an *END* and endurance will have finally reached its goal (and end). So, for now, we keep going, knowing every day, we are one day closer to finally reaching the end: **HEAVEN**.

That's what the church member was talking about on their way out of church that day. They were one day closer to reaching, by grace through faith in Jesus Christ, their life in heaven with the Lord and all His redeemed. No matter the stage of life we are in, it's good for us to look forward. It's also good for us to live one day at a time, seeking to make the most of each day and to enjoy the goodness God has for us in that day.

When writing this article, I stumbled across a family's website about a ministry called "One Day Closer." This family lost their 15-year old son in a tragic accident. After a period of grieving, the family came to a realization. In their words, "In our tragedy, it is tempting for us to count down the days that we survive without our son, but it's time to count forward to heaven." The family also realized, "God's desire for us isn't just to have a decent life on earth until we get to our eternal life in heaven, He wants our lives on earth to be full, purposeful and overflowing. For us that is loving the Lord with our whole hearts, loving others, sharing the hope of Jesus with others and continuing to make disciples. As Matthew 24:14 says, 'This gospel of the kingdom will be proclaimed throughout the whole world as a testimony to all nations, and then the end will come.' Each day we are one day closer to heaven and we have one day less to tell of the goodness of our Heavenly Father and our hope of salvation. We want to make the most of each day here making much of Jesus."



This month's hymn may be less familiar to some people, but for those who have been in Lutheran Churches around the country for any length of time (especially during the Easter season), you may have heard of a guy by the name of C.F.W. Walther. He is one of the founders of our church body (the Lutheran Church–Missouri Synod). When people first sang his hymn (which was originally written in German, and then translated to English), they likely were not fond of learning a new hymn. I have brought some newer tunes to this congregation in the first year of leading the music here, and I am always looking to have people sing their faith: "but short was their [devil's and demons'] triumph; the Savior arose...He lives, yes, He lives!"

When presented with a new tune for the first time, some people may choose not to sing. One way I try to encourage all people to sing newer tunes is that the whole congregation might not sing the first verse. Sometimes the choir may sing that first verse. Being able to listen to how the melody goes one time can help people feel more confident. With that in mind, let us sing to the Lord a new song!






