# What Comes Next?

I like to take my time when traveling long distances. Back-country roads, where the speed limit sits between 45 and 55, suit me just fine. My dog Lily and I began our trek southward from our townhome, a middle unit with cedar siding painted red, only a three-minute walk from the Erie Canal. From that freshly sealed driveway, we jumped in the car and headed south to Winter Haven, Florida.

The world changes quite a bit over the course of 1300 miles. Each place, every state, town, city, or country road bringing a new surprise or different flavor of culture. A new accent, some famous landmark, and, of course, a change in people. As someone who likes to get off the interstate and travel the backroads, I find myself continually surprised by the places I get to see and the people I get to meet.

There is so much to appreciate in this world that it's hard to be still, and yet all these things can pass you by in an instant if you don't learn to slow down. Amidst change, it's hard to take a moment, step back, and appreciate what God is doing. Too often, when change comes, our first response is to dive in head first and tackle as much as possible. We like to create our to do list of this, that, and the other. While this might help get things going or calm the anxiety that comes with change, what we often miss out on is the opportunity to breathe, step back, and appreciate what God is doing through this change.

The past month has been a time of transition for all of us. Grace has been in this transition for a much longer time. Waiting for a new associate, praying for him, and letting God lead and guide on His own time is no easy thing. The old JG Wentworth slogan comes to mind: "It's my money, and I need it now!" To rephrase it, we might more frequently pray to God, "It's my time, and I want things done on my time!" We want this or that done when it is most convenient and comfortable for us.

Whether we like it or not, that's not how God works. God's timing is often uncomfortable. He brings about change when we feel comfortable; He speeds past us when we can barely catch our breath; and He calls us to slow down when all we want to do is go go go. God challenges us in these moments to trust in Him; to rely on His timing, and trust His direction.

For me, I am so grateful to be here at Grace - to join in the ministry of this congregation. I'm eager to partner with our staff, to make a joyful noise with our school, and to grow together as deeply-rooted disciples of our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ. I'm eager to settle into an apartment, get to know the community, and make a home here among you; to discover dog parks, eat at new restaurants, and make new friends. I want these things to happen in an instant, but the realization is this: these things come in God's timing.

Since arriving at Grace, I've been asking God, "So, what comes next?" Perhaps you've asked that same question of yourself. "After waiting a year, God has supplied the associate... So, what comes next?" Proverbs 16:9 says, "In their hearts humans plan their course, but the Lord establishes their steps."

Our God is amazing. He stands at our side working with us and through us. Sometimes He's there pulling us back. Sometimes He's pushing us forward. Sometimes He simply stands there watching, hands folded, patiently twirling his thumbs with a cheeky smile and saying, "Be still, and know that I am God." (Psalm 46:10) Nothing surprises our God. He already knows what comes next, and that's ours to discover together in His time and fashion. Family of Grace, I am so excited to be with you all, to join in the blessed ministry of this congregation, and see what God has in store for us. God is at work; let's see what He's up to next!



These student leaders will help represent their peers, plan events, and serve as role models throughout the school year. We are proud of their willingness to step up and look forward to the great things they will accomplish together!


#### Athletics
