

## Dr. Myron Carl Munday

Trinity United Methodist Church Organist and Artist-in-Residence 1984-1995



Dr. Myron Carl Munday

Dr. Myron C. Munday served as Trinity's Organist and Artist-in-Residence from 1984 to 1995. Myron was an accomplished musician, holding a bachelor's degree in music from Morris Brown College in Atlanta, master's degree Northwestern University in Evanston, and a master's degree and doctorate from Florida State University. He also attended Brevard Music Center in North Carolina and the Royal Conservatory of Music in Toronto. His performances include recitals and chamber-music concerts throughout the United States and Canada.

He distinguished himself as a scholar and composer, conducting extensive research in the field of Black composers who have written works for the keyboard. Additionally, he served as choir master and organist at Union Baptist Church and Ebenezer Baptist Church, was on the music faculty of Spelman College, and performed for more than 5,000 children as an Artist-in-Residence with the Atlanta and Tallahassee school systems. Awards he received include the Martin Luther King Jr. Award for Artistic Achievement and an honorary Lieutenant Colonel Aide de Camp Certificate.

Myron was beloved by many for his vivacious spirit, musical artistry, and all-encompassing love. He served as Trinity's Organist and Artist-in-Residence from 1984 until his untimely death on November 7, 1995. Four Spiritual arrangements being performed in today's worship service were commissioned in honor of his memory.

# Special Music Commissioned to Honor the Memory of Dr. Myron C. Munday

November 9, 2025

An anonymous Trinity member initiated and sponsored the composition of music to honor the memory of Dr. Myron C. Munday. Criteria for the chosen composer included expertise in African American music and the ability to incorporate Spirituals into the compositions. The choice was immediately given to our local maestro, Dr. Mark Butler.

Dr. Mark Butler is the Director of Choral Studies and Activities at Florida A & M University in Tallahassee, Florida. As a composer, he has published over 20 original works and has commissioned works for music conferences, festivals, and various vocal competitions. His compositions are being performed at National and International music events such as the American Choral Directors' Association, music conferences, and festivals. Publishers of his works include Hinshaw Music, Colla Voce, Carl Fischer, and "Journey" Publications.

This commission is a compilation comprising one Civil Rights song arrangement and three Spiritual arrangements. Composed for this purpose and debuted today are Butler's arrangements of the following:

- I Got Shoes -This Little Light [for solo Organ]
- Go Down Moses [for solo Organ]
- We Shall Overcome [SATB voices & piano]
   [orchestra accompaniment available as well]
- Is There Anybody Here He's a Mighty Good Leader [SATB voice with Organ or piano accompaniment]

We offer our gratitude to Dr. Mark Butler for his compositions, to our Trinity musicians for their musical gifts, to Trinity members for their support of our music programs, and to Dr. Myron C. Munday for a lasting legacy of musical artistry, spiritual vibrance, and cultural awareness.
