God speaks to humanity through his created world

¹ The heavens declare the glory of God,
and the sky above proclaims his handiwork. *shamayim* =

² Day to day pours out speech,
and night to night reveals knowledge. *raqia* = sky,
³ There is no speech, nor are there words, firmament, expanse
whose voice is not heard. *cabod* = glory,
weight, heaviness

⁴ Their voice goes out through all the earth,
and their words to the end of the world.

YHWH speaks through the Torah

- ⁷ The law of the LORD is perfect, reviving the soul;
the testimony of the LORD is sure, making wise the simple;
⁸ the precepts of the LORD are right, rejoicing the heart;
the commandment of the LORD is pure, enlightening the eyes;
⁹ the fear of the LORD is clean, enduring forever;
the rules of the LORD are true, and righteous altogether.
¹⁰ More to be desired are they than gold, even much fine gold;
sweeter also than honey and drippings of the honeycomb.
¹¹ Moreover, by them is your servant warned;
in keeping them there is great reward.

10 statements about the law / 5 verses
(10 commandments / Pentateuch)

The worshiper responds

- ¹² Who can discern his errors?
Declare me innocent from hidden faults.
¹³ Keep back your servant also from presumptuous sins;
let them not have dominion over me!
Then I shall be blameless, and innocent of great transgression.
¹⁴ Let the words of my mouth and the meditation of my heart
be acceptable in your sight, *Hagah* (meditation)
O LORD, my rock and my redeemer.

The Theology of Psalm 19

- God is both **immanent** and **transcendent**
- God wants to be known (**relational**)
- YHWH is the God of all creation (**not a local deity**)
- The **laws of nature** and the **moral law** both reveal God's glory
- God's **world** and his **word speak the same reality** (science and scripture do not conflict)
- The **Torah stands between God and man** as the revelation of God and the means of salvation
- YHWH is **Rock** and **Redeemer**

Psalm 29 – Water and Weather

- ¹ Ascribe to the LORD, **O heavenly beings**, ascribe to the LORD glory and strength.
- ² Ascribe to the LORD the glory due his name; worship the LORD in the splendor of holiness.
- ³ The **voice of the LORD** is **over the waters**; West
the God of glory thunders,
the LORD, **over many waters**.
- ⁴ The **voice of the LORD** is powerful;
the **voice of the LORD** is full of majesty.
- ⁵ The **voice of the LORD** breaks the cedars; North
the LORD breaks the cedars of **Lebanon**.
- ⁶ He makes **Lebanon** to skip like a calf,
and **Sirion** like a young wild ox.



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Psalm 29 – Water and Weather

- ⁷ The **voice of the LORD** flashes forth flames of fire.
- ⁸ The **voice of the LORD** shakes the wilderness;
the LORD shakes the wilderness of Kadesh. South
- ⁹ The **voice of the LORD** makes the deer give birth
and strips the forests bare,
and in his temple all cry, "Glory!"
- ¹⁰ The **LORD sits enthroned over the flood**;
the LORD sits enthroned as king forever.
- ¹¹ May the LORD give **strength** to his people!
May the LORD bless his people with **peace**!

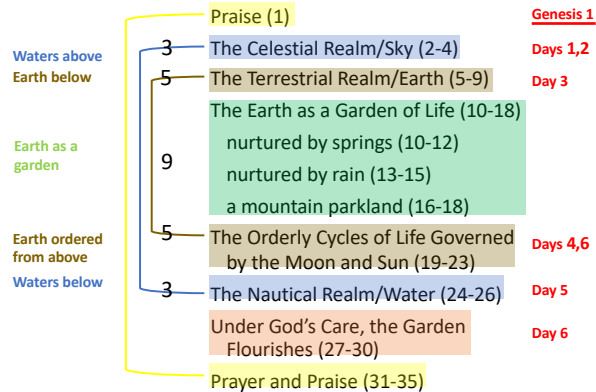

Under God's Care, the Garden Flourishes (27-30)

- ²⁷ These all look to you,
to give them their food in due season.
- ²⁸ When you give it to them, they gather it up;
when you open your hand, they are filled with good things.
- ²⁹ When you hide your face, they are dismayed;
when you take away their breath, they die
and return to their dust.
- ³⁰ When you send forth your Spirit, ^[c] they are created,
and you renew the face of the ground. *Adamah (ground)*
