


⁷ Tychicus will give you a full report about how I am getting along.

—to let you know how we are doing and to encourage you.



These are the only Jewish believers among my co-workers; they are working with me here for the Kingdom of God.




Epaphras, a member of your own fellowship and a servant of Christ Jesus, sends you his greetings.
 He always prays earnestly for you, asking God to make you strong and perfect, fully confident that you are following the whole will of God.




¹³ I can assure you that he prays hard for you and also for the believers in Laodicea and Hierapolis.




¹⁴ Luke, the beloved doctor, sends his greetings, and so does Demas.




¹⁵ Please give my greetings to our brothers and sisters at Laodicea, and to Nympha and the church that meets in her house.




After you have read this letter, pass it on to the church at Laodicea so they can read it, too. And you should read the letter I wrote to them.




And I want you to know, my dear brothers and sisters, that everything that has happened to me here has helped to spread the Good News.

17 Those others do not have pure motives as they preach about Christ. They preach with selfish ambition, not sincerely, intending to make my chains more painful to me.




18 But that doesn't matter.

ACTS 11


ACTS 16

² Timothy was well thought of by the believers in Lystra and Iconium, ³ so Paul wanted him to join them on their journey. In deference to the Jews of the area, he arranged for Timothy to be circumcised before they left, for everyone knew that his father was a Greek.

UNSOLVED TENSIONS



³⁷ Barnabas agreed and wanted to take along John Mark. ³⁸ But Paul disagreed strongly, since John Mark had deserted them in Pamphylia and had not continued with them in their work.





39 Their disagreement was so sharp that they separated.
Barnabas took John Mark with him and sailed for Cyprus. 40 Paul chose Silas, and as he left, the believers entrusted him to the Lord's gracious care.


2 TIMOTHY 4
