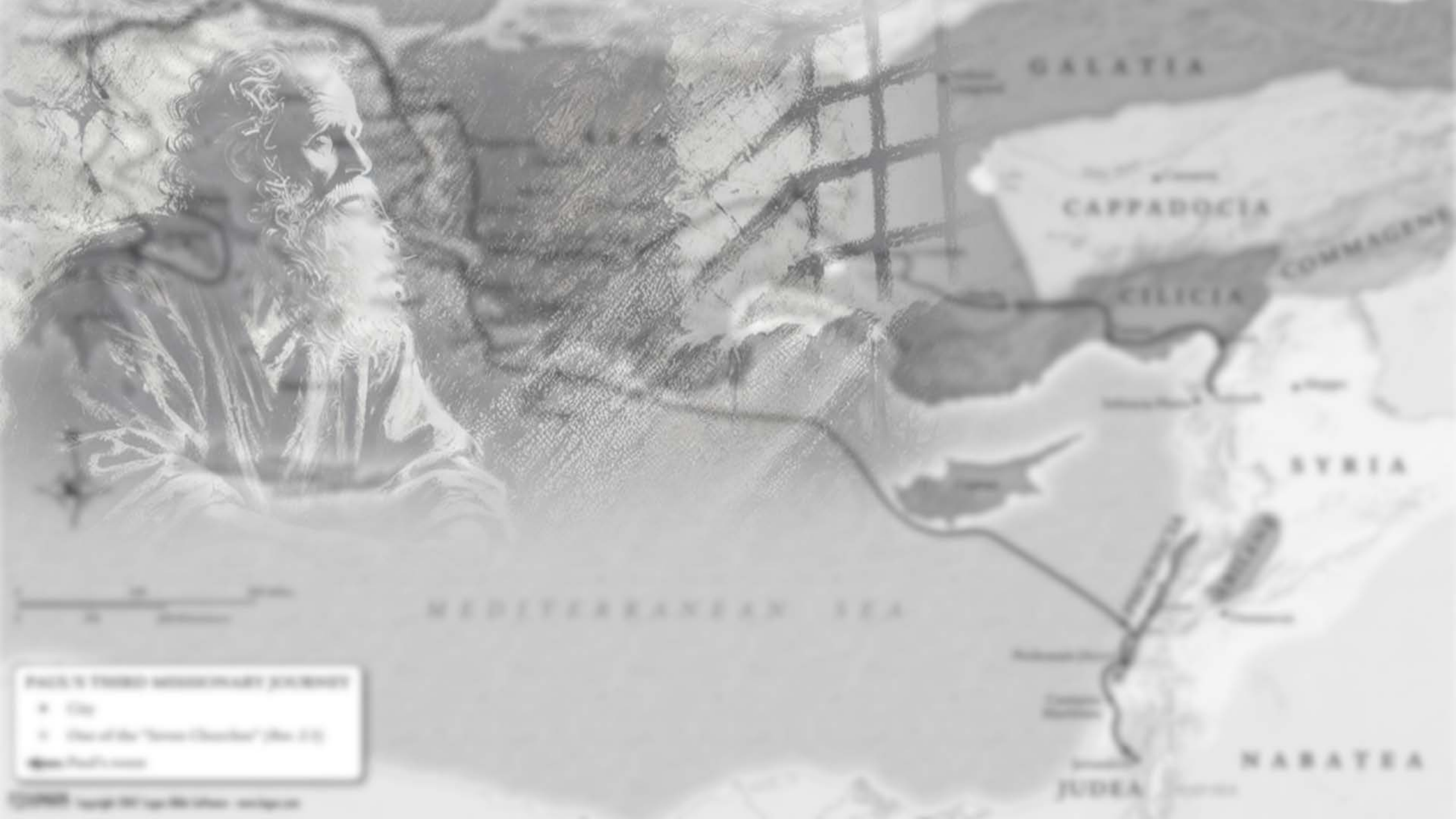

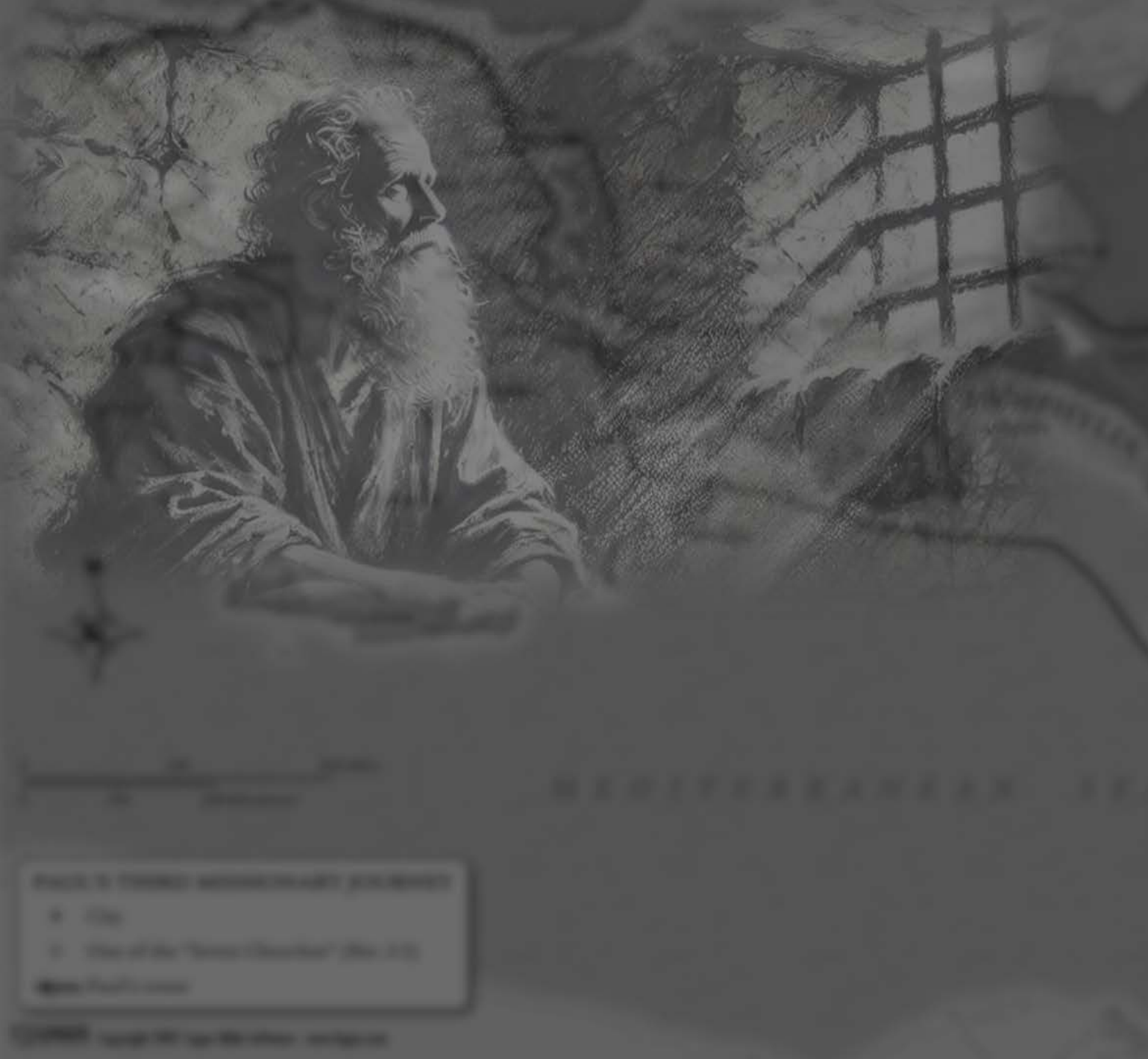

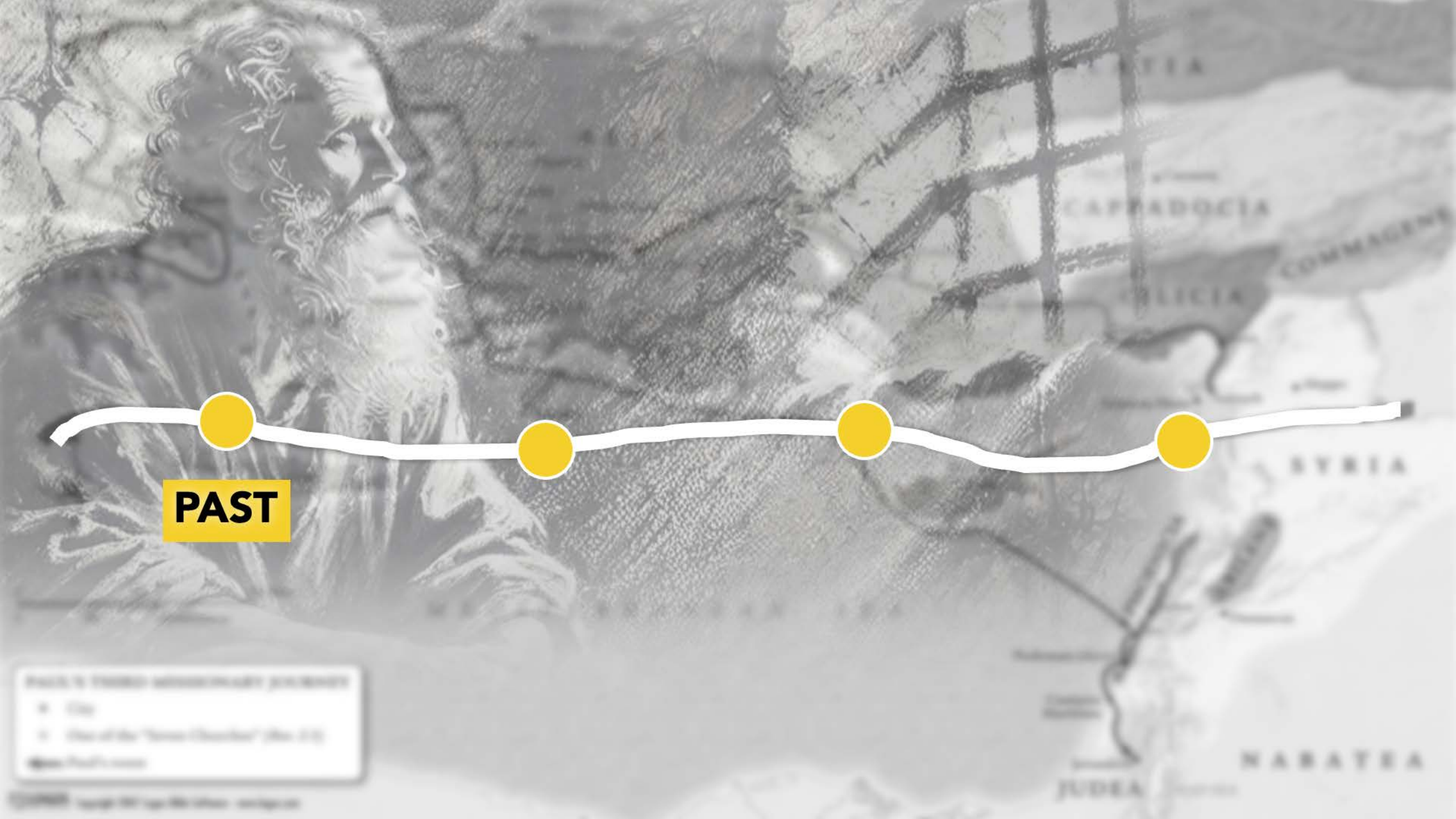

ACTS 22

⁴ And I persecuted the followers of the Way, hounding some to death, arresting both men and women and throwing them in prison.

⁵ The high priest and the whole council of elders can testify that this is so.



ACTS 22

For I received letters from them to our Jewish brothers in Damascus, authorizing me to bring the followers of the Way from there to Jerusalem, in chains, to be punished.



ACTS 9

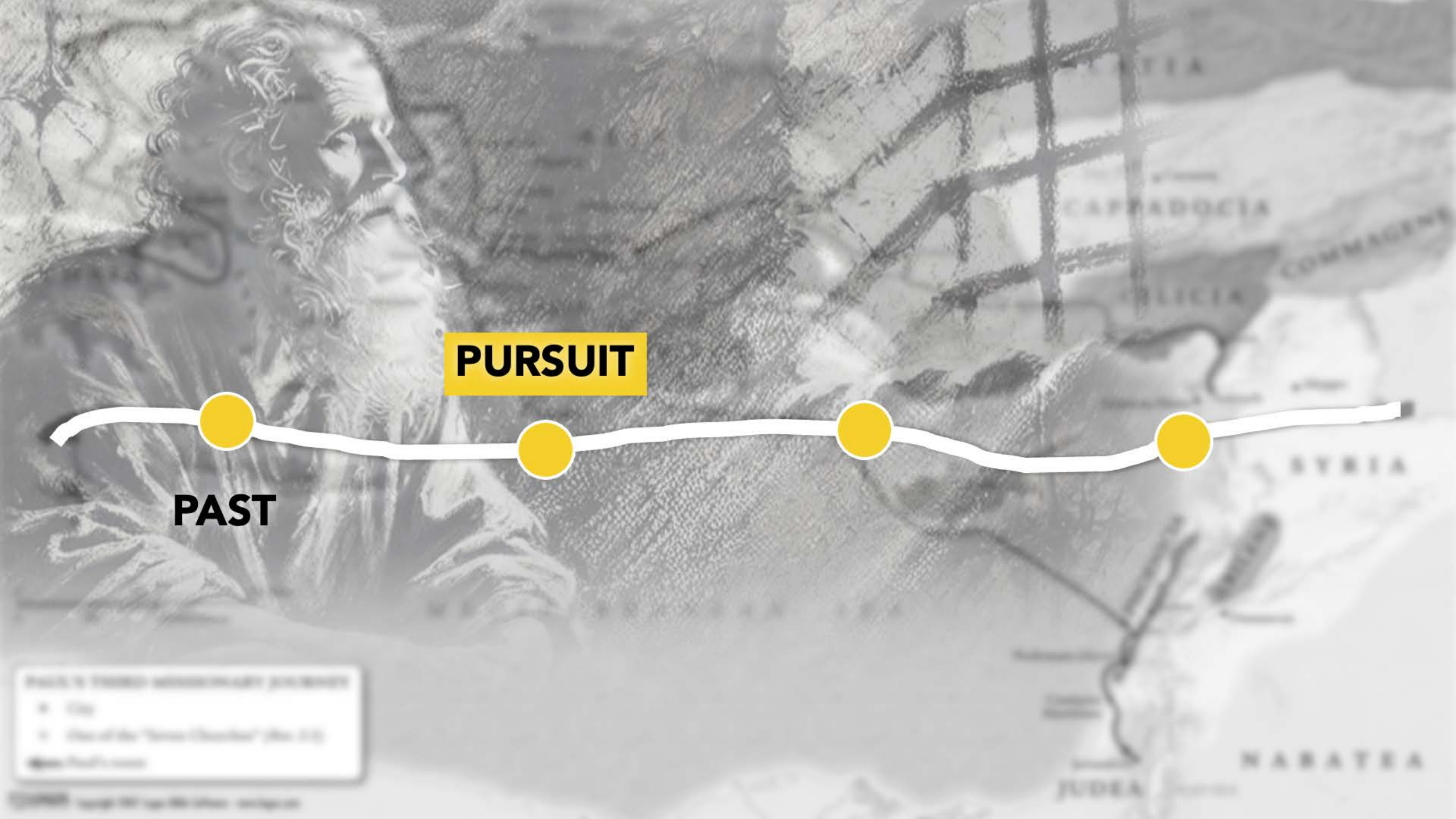

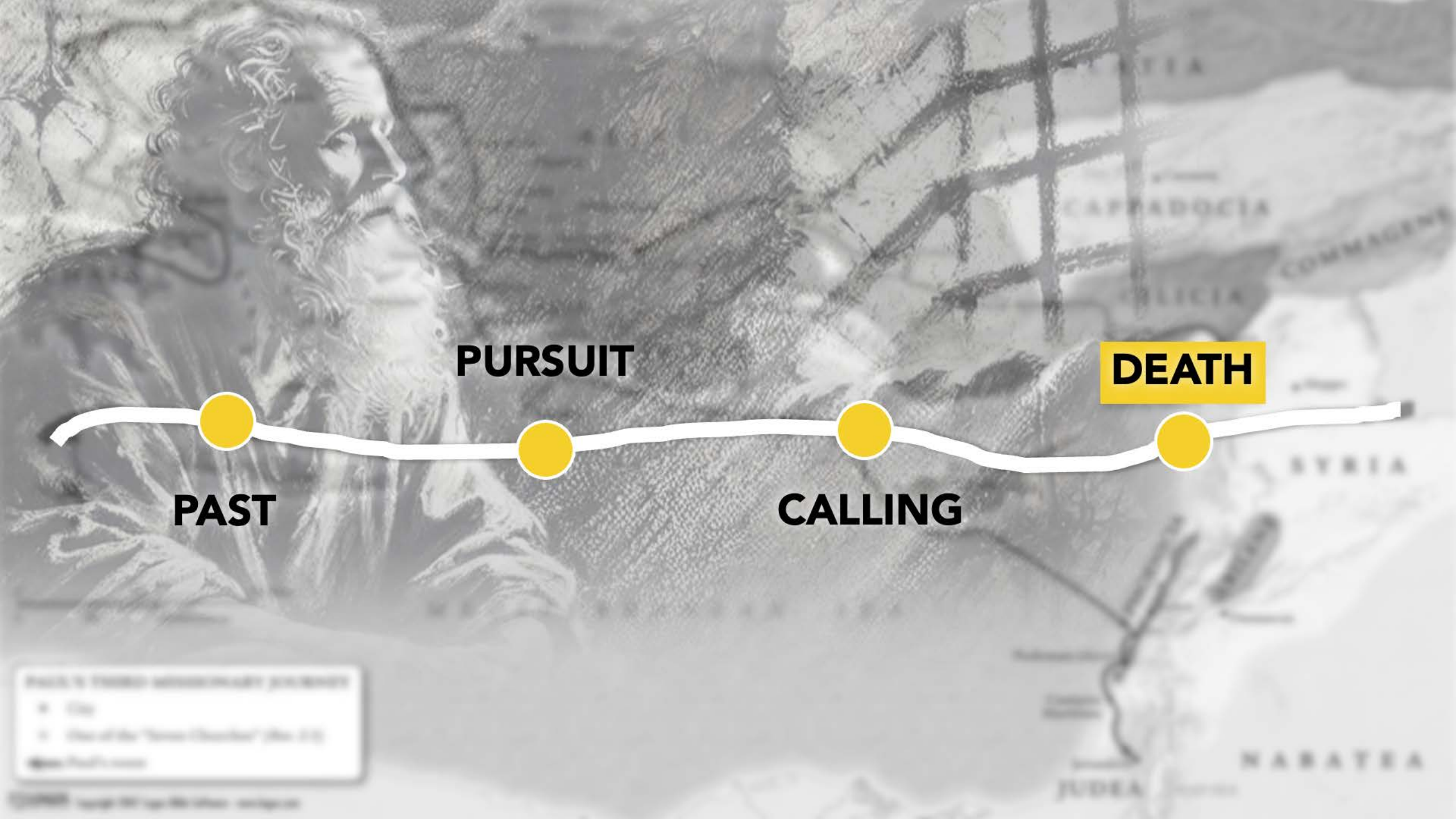
