MONTHLY PRAYER GUIDE



"Continue steadfastly in prayer, being watchful in it with thanksgiving.

At the same time, pray also for me, that God may open to us a door for the word, to declare the mystery of Christ."

- Colossians 4:2-3 (ESV)

One of the core values of Crossings is **prayer**- "the joy of supplication, the refreshment of confession, the ministry of intercession, the power of warfare, and the sacrifice of praise." We believe that when God's people unite their hearts, minds, and voices in prayer together, God is honored and his Kingdom advances in a powerful, transformative way.

This is the aim of this **Prayer Guide**- to provide the people of Crossings with a unified rhythm of intentional, intercessory prayer for each day of the month. It is highly specific to the unique context of Crossings *on purpose*- we want to pray together for the people (elders, staff members, volunteer teams and leaders, mission partners, etc) whom God has gathered here in this time and place for his great purposes.

We have included some specific prayer prompts for each day to help you get started, but we hope that you will personalize this guide as the Holy Spirit moves your heart and brings to your awareness specific praises, thanksgivings, needs, and opportunities for the individuals and groups included below.
