123Devo is a simplified tool to help you grow in your faith. The concept is based off Isaiah 6:1-8. In these passages, we find 3 simple steps showing us how to more deeply reflect and respond to the Word.

The 3 steps are:

- 1) See – What is God showing me?
- 2) Say – What is God saying to me and what do I need to say to Him?
- 3) Send – What will I do with what I have seen and heard?

1. SEE: “What is God showing me?”

“...I saw the Lord sitting upon a throne,...” – Isaiah 6:1 ESV

- What do you notice about God’s character, His Word, or your heart?
- This is about reverence, clarity, and focus and letting truth rise to the surface.
- What grabs my attention in the scriptures(s) today?

2. SAY: “What is God saying to me and what do I need to say to Him?”

“And I said: ‘Woe is me!...’ – Isaiah 6:5 ESV

“...I heard the voice of the Lord saying,...” – Isaiah 6:8 ESV

- What is God saying through His Word and Holy Spirit? What is your reply?
- Reflect on what truth is rising in your heart: comfort, correction, conviction?

Follow-up questions:

- What is God pointing out in me or around me?
- What do I need to confess, declare, or believe?

3. SEND: “What will I do with what I’ve seen and heard?”

“...Here I am! Send me.” – Isaiah 6:8 ESV

- God’s Word is for a reason, we must step into action.
- This question calls for obedience and mission, we must walk past mere insight.
- How is God inviting you to respond, act, serve, pray, or speak today?

Follow-up question:

- What step of obedience am I being sent into?
