### ☐ *Day 1 - Unity & Understanding*

10 I appeal to you, brothers, by the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, that all of you agree, and that there be no divisions among you, but that you be united in the same mind and the same judgment.

(1 Corinthians 1:10)

### ☐ *Day 2 - Forgiveness*

31 Let all bitterness and wrath and anger and clamor and slander be put away from you, along with all malice.

32 Be kind to one another, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, as God in Christ forgave you.

(Ephesians 4:31-32)

### ☐ *Day 3 - Restoration*

8 Above all, keep loving one another earnestly, since love covers a multitude of sins.

(1 Peter 4:8)

12 Put on then, as God's chosen ones, holy and beloved, compassionate hearts, kindness, humility, meekness, and patience, 13 bearing with one another and, if one has a complaint against another, forgiving each other; as the Lord has forgiven you, so you also must forgive. 14 And above all these put on love, which binds everything together in perfect harmony. 5 If any of you lacks wisdom, let him ask God, who gives generously to all without reproach, and it will be given him.

## ☐ *Day 5 - Patience & Kindness*

4 Love is patient and kind; love does not envy or boast; it is not arrogant or rude.

29 Let no corrupting talk come out of your mouths, but only such as is good for building up, as fits the occasion, that it may give grace to those who hear.

## ☐ *Day 6 - Passion in Intimacy & Connection*

4 For the wife does not have authority over her own body, but the husband does. Likewise the husband does not have authority over his own body, but the wife does. 5 Do not deprive one another, except perhaps by agreement for a limited time, that you may devote yourselves to prayer; but then come together again, so that Satan may not tempt you because of your lack of self-control.  
(1 Corinthians 7:4-5)

## ☐ *Day 7 - Peace in Conflict*

9 Blessed are the peacemakers, for they shall be called sons of God.  
(Matthew 5:9)

12 For we do not wrestle against flesh and blood, but against the rulers, against the authorities, against the cosmic powers over this present darkness, against the spiritual forces of evil in the heavenly places.  
(Ephesians 6:12)

## □ *Day 8 - Spiritual Growth Together*

17 You therefore, beloved, knowing this beforehand, take care that you are not carried away with the error of lawless people and lose your own stability. 18 But grow in the grace and knowledge of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. To him be the glory both now and to the day of eternity. Amen.

for God will judge the sexually immoral and adulterous.  
(Hebrews 13:4)

## □ *Day 13 - Growing in Love & Respect*

22 Wives, submit to your own husbands, as to the Lord. 23 For the husband is the head of the wife even as Christ is the head of the church, his body, and is himself its Savior. 24 Now as the church submits to Christ, so also wives should submit in everything to their husbands. 25 Husbands, love your wives, as Christ loved the church and gave himself up for her, 26 that he might sanctify her, having cleansed her by the washing of water with the word, 27 so that he might present the church to himself in splendor, without spot or wrinkle or any such thing, that she might be holy and without blemish. 28 In the same way husbands should love their wives as their own bodies. He who loves his wife loves himself.

## □ *Day 24 - Leading Our Family Christ Honoring*

4 Fathers, do not provoke your children to anger, but bring them up in the discipline and instruction of the Lord.  
(Ephesians 6:4)

3 Behold, children are a heritage from the Lord, the fruit of the womb a reward. 4 Like arrows in the hand of a warrior are the children of one's youth. 5 Blessed is the man who fills his quiver with them! He shall not be put to shame when he speaks with his enemies in the gate.

## □ *Day 25 - Our Children's Salvation & Spiritual Growth*

(Ephesians 2:8-10)

## ☐ *Day 32 - Peace in Our Home*

15 And let the peace of Christ rule in your hearts, to which indeed you were called in one body. And be thankful.  
(Colossians 3:15)

18 My people will abide in a peaceful habitation, in secure dwellings, and in quiet resting places.  
(Isaiah 32:18)

## ☐ *Day 33 - Christ Honoring Obedience from Children*

8 Hear, my son, your father's instruction, and forsake not your mother's teaching.  
(Proverbs 1:8)

12 "Honor your father and your mother, that your days may be long in the land that the Lord your God is giving you.  
(Exodus 20:12)

## ☐ *Day 34 - Godliness in Parenting*

4 Fathers, do not provoke your children to anger, but bring them up in the discipline and instruction of the Lord.  
(Ephesians 6:4)

26 She opens her mouth with wisdom, and the teaching of kindness is on her tongue. 27 She looks well to the ways  
of her household and does not eat the bread of idleness.

## ☐ *Day 36 - Service & Humility in Marriage*

3 Do nothing from selfish ambition or conceit, but in humility count others more significant than yourselves. 4 Let  
each of you look not only to his own interests, but also to the interests of others.  
(Philippians 2:3-4)

6 But he gives more grace. Therefore it says, "God opposes the proud but gives grace to the humble."  
(James 4:6)

## ☐ *Day 37 - Christ Centered Home*

15 And if it is evil in your eyes to serve the Lord, choose this day whom you will serve, whether the gods your fathers  
served in the region beyond the River, or the gods of the Amorites in whose land you dwell.  
But as for me and my house, we will serve the Lord.  
(Joshua 24:15)
