Psalm 18, ... A Psalm of David, the servant of the LORD...

I love you, O LORD, my strength. The LORD is my rock, my fortress, and my deliverer...my shield, the horn of my salvation, my stronghold. I call upon the LORD, who is worthy to be praised, and I am saved from my enemies.

The cords of death encompassed me...the snares of death confronted me. In my distress I called upon the LORD...from his temple he heard my voice, and my cry reached his ears. Then the earth reeled and rocked...smoke went up from his nostrils, and devouring fire from his mouth. He bowed the heavens and came down...he rode on a cherub and flew...the LORD thundered in the heavens, and the Most High uttered his voice. He sent out his arrows and scattered them; he flashed forth lightning and routed them.

He sent from on high, he took me...he rescued me from my strong enemy, for they were too mighty for me. They confronted me in the day of my calamity, but the LORD was my support. He brought me out into a broad place; he rescued me, because he delighted in me.

The LORD dealt with me according to my righteousness...for I have kept the ways of the LORD. With the merciful you show yourself merciful; with the blameless you show yourself blameless; with the purified you show yourself pure; and with the crooked you make yourself seem tortuous. You save a humble people, but the haughty eyes you bring down.

It is you who light my lamp; the LORD my God lightens my darkness. By you I can run against a troop, and by my God I can leap over a wall. This God—his way is perfect; the word of the LORD proves true; he is a shield for all who take refuge in him. Who is God, but the LORD? And who is a rock, except our God?—the God who equipped me with strength and made my way...
