Jesus said to them, “Truly I tell you, unless you eat the flesh of the Son of Man and drink his blood, you do not have life in yourselves. The one who eats my flesh and drinks my blood has eternal life, and I will raise him up on the last day,

# PASTORAL PRAYER

---

The Pastoral Prayer is led by one of Palmdale Church's elders. This is the time in our liturgy where we bring our requests to God.

# BENEDICTION

---

At the end of Palmdale Church's worship gathering, the benediction is a blessing spoken over the congregation. It asks for God's peace, guidance, and protection to be with everyone as they leave, empowering them to carry the message of the service into their daily lives.
