Lord Jesus Christ, we worship and adore you. As God, you are in the bosom of your Father: as man, you are in the womb of your mother. As God, you fill all things; as man, you are confined to a cradle. As God, you are clothed in a robe of glory; as man, you are wrapped in coarse swaddling bands. As God, you are encircled by millions of bright angels; as man, you are in the company of Joseph and Mary. As God, you are all-sufficient and without need; as man, you submit to an inglorious condition. With what less than ravishment of spirit can I behold you, who from everlasting were clothed with glory, now wrapped in rags, cradled in a manger, exposed to hunger, weariness, danger, contempt? Into what ecstasies may I be cast, to see the Judge of all the world accused. to see the Lord of life dying on the tree of shame, to see the eternal Son struggling with his Father's wrath? Oh, where has your love to mankind carried you? Had you sent creatures to serve us,

But you came yourself, and you came to lay down your lifeblood, all for your people. That you should be cursed, that we might be blessed; forsaken, that we might not be forsaken: condemned, that we might be acquitted: oh, what raptures of spirit can be sufficient for the admiration of this so infinite mercy? Be swallowed up, O my soul, in this depth of divine love. Listen to the attributes of God. Mercy cries. "I am abused." Patience cries, "I am despised." Goodness cries, "I am wronged." Holiness cries. "I am contradicted." All come to the Father crying out for justice. Listen as Christ steps in: "I will bear all, and satisfy all." Look upon him as he hangs on the cross, all naked, all torn, all bloody, between heaven and earth. O love more deep than hell! O love more high than heaven! *The brightest seraphim are but as sparkles* to the mighty flame of love in the heart of Jesus.
