PASTOR'S

Standing at the school I saw some preschoolers clinging to their mom's leg not ready to leave. A sad dad wept while their child walked into school. For them this was not an exciting adventure, but instead a threat! Sure others ran in without a care in the world, but there is also anxiety.

School is meant to teach what we need for life: Reading, writing, arithmetic, history, science, and the arts. We pray for the many teachers of both public and private school systems. Many are sincere and desire to train our little ones with what they need. Yet, when children are away from there

Christian parents and the security of their home and church, Satan has a desire the lead them astrav. He uses other children to tempt them to follow their sinful desires. Satan uses well-meaning but illadvised adults who auestion the faith. There always seems to be one teacher who does this openly. This is where St. Paul's school has the advantage employing only openly

professing Christians! There are still real threats, unrealized dangers from vehicle crashes, to a student who snaps and becomes a bad actor. Sometimes, Satan uses us as his agents when he gets just a small foothold in our life, to change us from following the Lord to our own pride.

Psalm 91 gives us two strong promises to calm us: "Whoever dwells in the shelter of the Most High will rest in the shadow of the Almighty. I will say of the Lord, "He is my refuge and my fortress, my God, in whom I trust." Surely he will save you from the fowler's snare and from the deadly pestilence." The picture here is of a bird being caught in a trap/snare. When the great "I AM" i.e. "the Lord" is our refuge he will save us from pestilence, dangers at school, and other trouble.

The promise is repeated, "If you say, "The Lord is my refuge," and you make the Most High your dwelling, no harm will overtake you, no disaster will come near your tent. For he will command his angels concerning you to

guard you in all your ways; they will lift you up in their hands, so that you will not strike your foot against a stone."

Psalm 91's point, not any of Satan's traps, the world, or our sinful self can ultimately win. Jesus answered Satan after he told Jesus that if he jumped off the temple God would rescue him: "It is also written: 'Do not put the Lord your God to the test." Obviously, we do not test God sending angels, but we know that he does. This is why when our children, neighbors, and fellow Christians are at home, we want to constantly pray with them, read

the Bible, take them to church so they are grounded in the promise and belief that he is our shelter, our roof, our fortress.

Today we know God has you in his hands. Trust he will take your children, fellow Christians and yourself through the traps.



Prayer: Lord Jesus, Help me to always take refuge in you. Save your people from the deadly pestilence. Guard all teachers and students that they would not be led astray by Satan. Keep them from all bad actors and bring them safely to your house. In Jesus' name. Amen.


Sunday School starts on Sunday, September 14 at 9:30 a.m.


What's ClassDojo?

ClassDojo is a global community of more than 50 million teachers and families who come together to share kids' most important learning moments, in school and at home—through photos, videos, messages, and more. Dear Friends, Greetings from the southern hemisphere where it feels like a switch has been flipped and overnight we have gone from Winter into Spring -- Spring being dry, dusty and hot; temps in the

mid 90's.

We continue to keep busy; Tim as a translation consultant working with three different translation teams, and the rest of us with school or house-related stuff. Last month I mentioned that Tim is working with the Wayeyi translators (Botswana, five hours south of us) checking the Gospel of John. Their plan is to meet one day each week via Zoom to get it done, which sounds good in theory, but has only happened twice due to a variety of reasons. We are seeing that this may not be the best plan for working with these guys, because even when Tim and the team are able to connect it is just difficult for Tim to show them what he wants them to see/do -- it is just so much easier when the meetings are in-person. Otherwise, Tim also continues to work with the Themne translation team in Sierra Leone, and is planning a trip there to work with them in two weeks.

But, of course, life is not all work. Tim and the boys have also been doing a lot of camping and making of memories before Aaron has to leave to go back to university. I (Lisa) appreciate indoor plumbing too much to really enjoy camping, so these trips have been a male only experience. They did a 5-day trip in Namibia to a couple of nature preserves and had a wonderful time; the highlight probably being seeing two lionesses on a hunt, though they also got to see the largest meteor in the world and a cute 4-month old rhino.

Tim continues to help Splash with the planning of the November dedication for the Khwedam panoramic Bible, though Splash is the one in charge. Please pray for Splash; that is a lot of responsibility riding on his shoulders.
