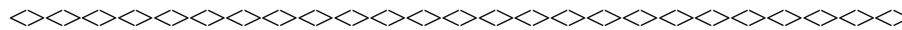
Nominating Committee Survey

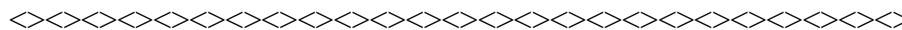

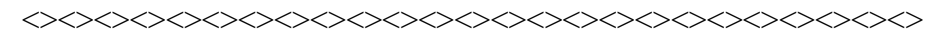
