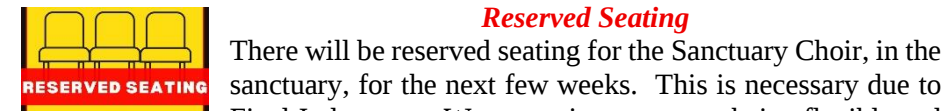

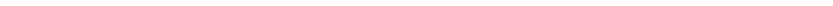
Samaritan Purse Christmas Shoe Boxes

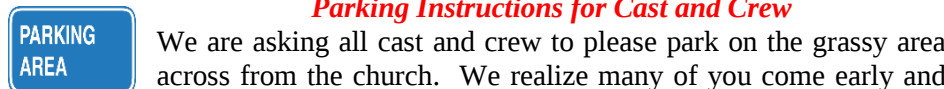
Also, if you picked up a box that did not have a suggested items sheet or a shipping label, please check on the table beside the preschool area for these items. Thanks!!!
