The Unsearchable Riches in Christ

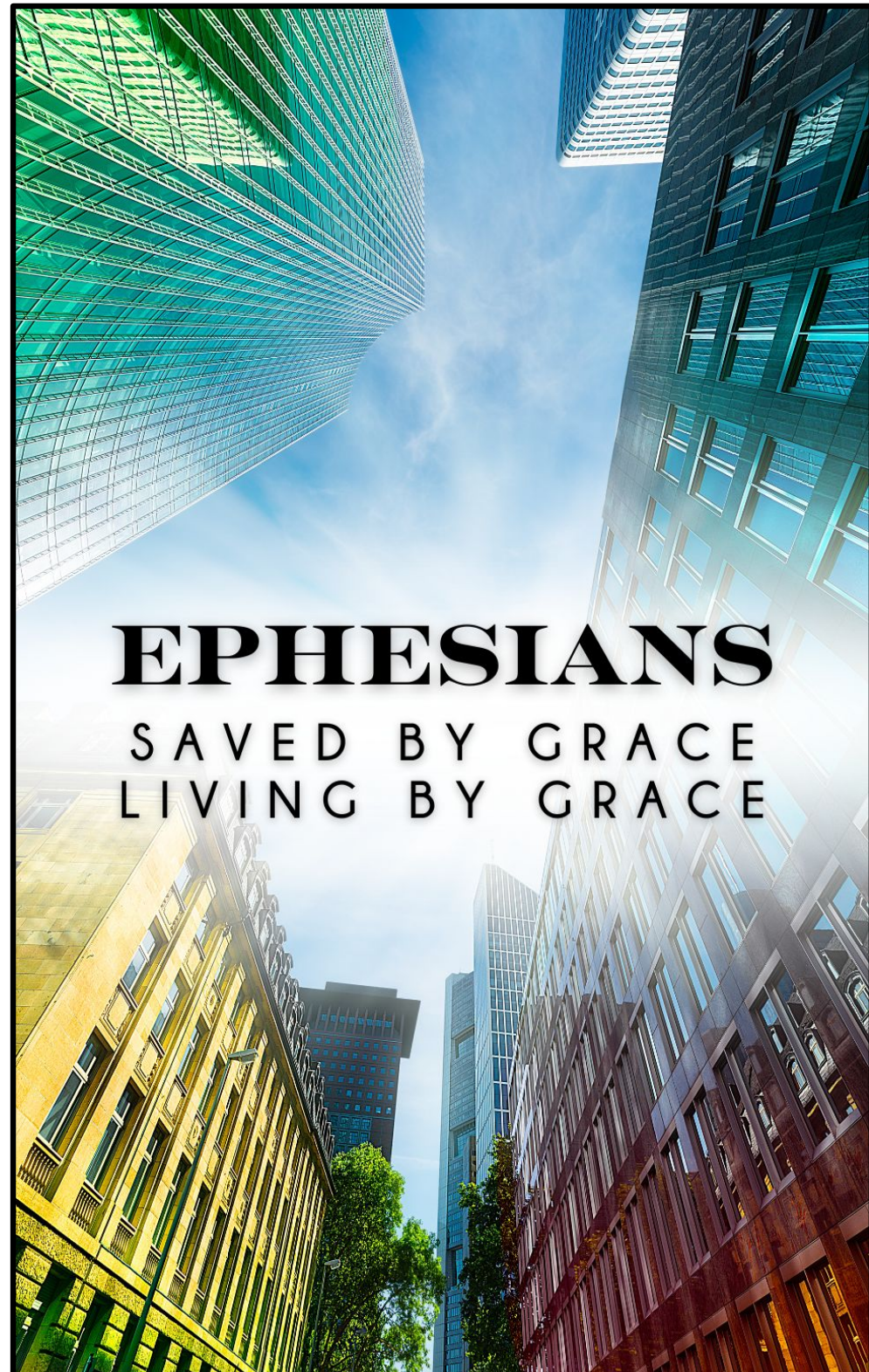
- I. The Riches of Christ are promised in the OT and revealed in the NT. 3:1 – 5

1:30pm Wed - Grief Share (*On break until Oct*)

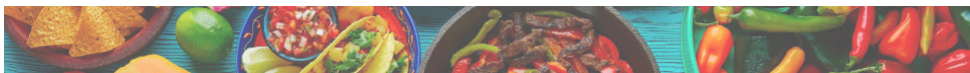
6pm Thurs - Ephesians Bible Study, in the Commons, led by Pastor Alan & Lisa Branch.
