DANIEL 2:1-19


THE NATURE OF A CRISIS:

1. Someone else's problem becomes your problem. 2:1-2
2. There seems to be no time to think; I feel I must act now. 2:3-4
3. If something is not done, bad things will happen. 2:5
4. There seems to be no answer. 2:6-10
5. It seems as if your world is coming to an end. 2:11-13

HOW TO BE CONFIDENT IN A CRISIS:

1. Discretion helps us make responsible decisions and keeps us from being careless. 2:14
2. Discernment helps us make right decisions and keeps us from being confused. 2:14
3. Deep courage protects us from rash decisions and keeps us from chaos. 2:15-16
4. Developing Christlike friendships helps us make redeemed decisions and keeps us from constant panic. 2:17
5. Developing convictional prayer helps us make resilient decisions and keeps us from crumbling under pressure. 2:18-19
