III. Give Positive Discipline and Instruction

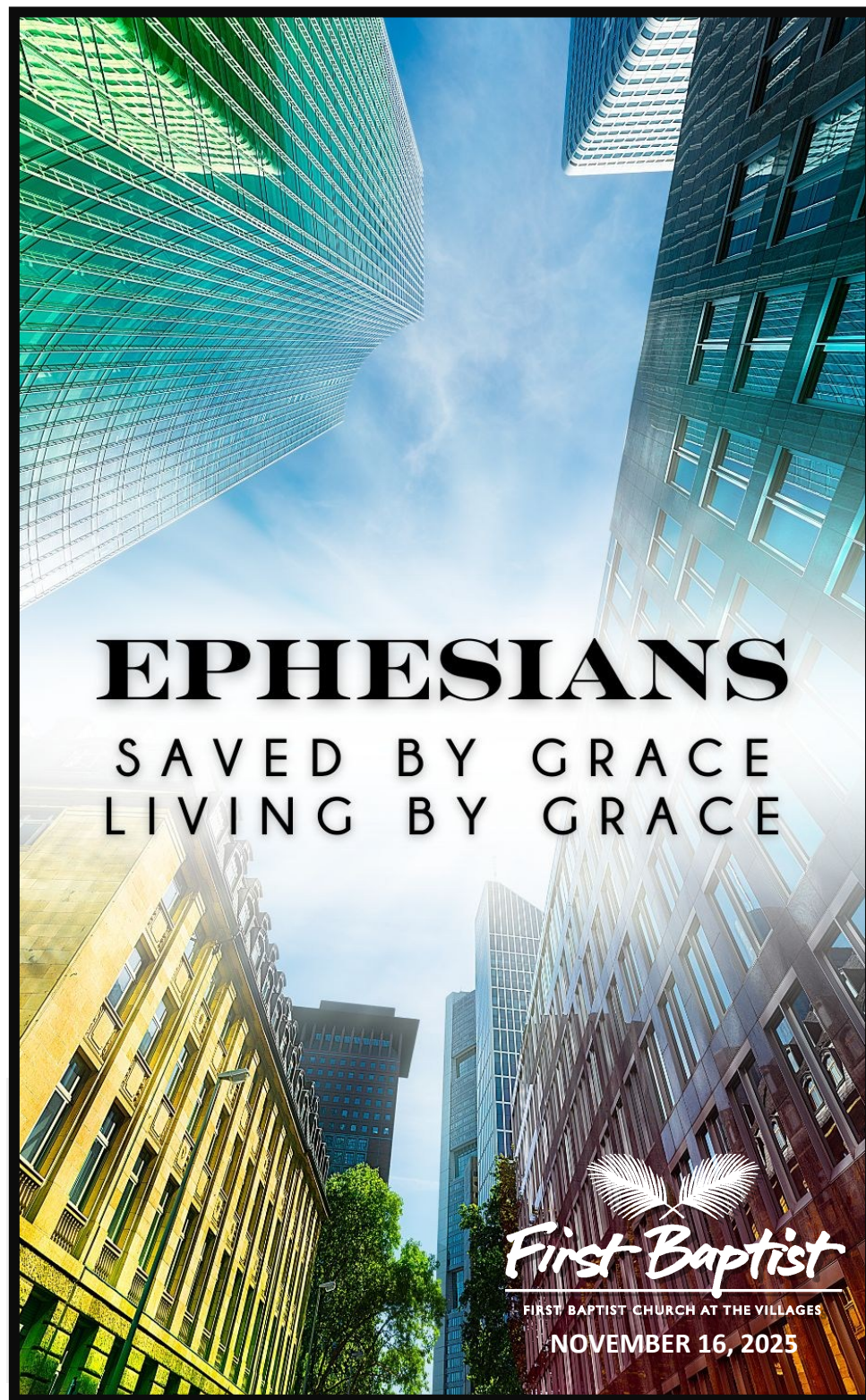
- *Distinguish between regular immaturity as opposed to rebellion.*
