
Kindness, Tenderness, and Forgiveness: Three Essential Virtues for a Lasting Marriage

- I. Four Habits Destructive to Marriage. 4:25 31, 5:18
 - A. While anger can be an appropriate emotion, it is volatile in marriage. 4:26 27
 - 1. Godly anger is righteous indignation at objective evil and is not the moral right of way to rage or be angry at your spouse.
 - 2. Anger that simmers opens the door to Satanic attack on your marriage.
 - B. Profanity feeds unholy anger and makes reconciliation more difficult. 4:29 31
 - C. Substance abuse is an accelerant to all the bad traits you do not want to occur in marriage. 5:18
 - D. Unforgiveness and Bitterness are conjoined twins. 4:31
- II. Three Virtues for a Lasting Marriage. 4:32
 - A. Kindness creates the atmosphere in which love grows.
 - B. Tenderheartedness creates the attitude that builds trust.
 - C. Forgiveness is the action that makes love last.
