- 1. Layers of Religion disguise the consequences of our sin. 5:1a
- 2. Layers of Religion distract from the baby born to suffer for our sins. 5:1b
- **3.** Layers of Religion downplay the humility of the Messiah's birth in Bethlehem. 5:2a
- 4. Layers of Religion deny the deity of Christ. 5:2b
- **5.** Layers of Religion detract from the Messiah's role as our shepherd. 5:4
- 6. Layers of Religion distort the real source of peace. 5:5

POINTS OF APPLICATION:

- **1.** Christmas reminds us that our sin problem must be addressed.
- 2. Christmas reminds us that God came on a rescue mission for you.
- **3.** Christmas reminds us that you need the Good Shepherd to guide you away from the destructive choices and towards constructive choices.
- **4.** Christmas reminds us that peace comes when you are reconciled to God by faith in His Son Jesus Christ.
