

KEY SCRIPTURE

Galatians 6:7 Don't be misled: No one makes a fool of God. What a person plants, he will harvest. The person who plants selfishness, ignoring the needs of others - ignoring God! 8 harvests a crop of weeds. All he'll have to show for his life is weeds! But the one who plants in response to God, letting God's Spirit do the growth work in him, harvests a crop of real life, eternal life.

QUESTIONS

- 1. Ps Eddie spoke of how patience allows us to reap a harvest, primarily because it helps us align our timeline and expectations with God's. Have you had a time in your life where you can look back in hindsight and see how God's timing was actually perfect versus when you initially expected?
- 2. Faithfulness often comes down to trusting in God's goodness, plan and purpose for our lives. When we remember God's faithfulness, it helps us to grow in faithfulness and patience ourselves as we wait on God. What are you waiting on right now in this season, and where do you need to remember God's faithfulness?
- 3. Pastor Eddie's final point was that we need to walk in patience and faithfulness towards others because it creates the opportunity that allows both us and others to grow in Christ. What areas of your life do you need to start allowing God's faithfulness and patience to begin flowing through you?
