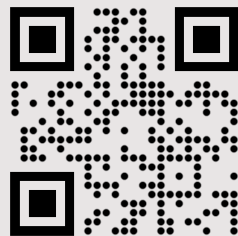

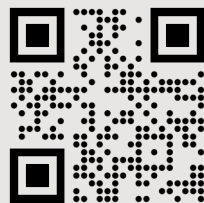

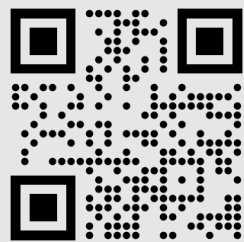

BAPTISM

FIRST COMMUNION

The age for first communion at All Saints is up to the discretion of the parents. You can download a copy of our Communicant Readiness Workbook from our website or pick up one in the Bookstore or the Children's Hall on Sunday morning. If you feel your child is ready to begin communing at All Saints, the next step is to set up a time for him or her to talk with a pastor or an elder.

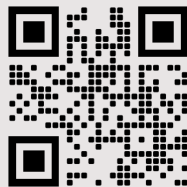
