

## Worship



# | Where Can I Serve?






For twelve weeks this fall, our attention and our questions will turn to the Gospel of Luke in our study, "The Servant King." We'll walk alongside Jesus and his disciples and witness the most extraordinary turn of events in the history of mankind.

But this is not just a historical account; it is a present-day invitation to follow Jesus in our world and live out our purpose together. The Bible is about God welcoming the weary world, and our purpose is to believe Jesus, and join Him as he brings many sons and daughters home to God.

## Fall Bible Study: The Prophet, Priest, King - Life as a Believer





Sign up to learn Spanish. These classes taught at multiple levels will help you master conversational Spanish.








## Music + Arts Lunches







  - Cost is \$20






# | Formation Groups
